- Any horse and rider changes throughout the weekend will kindly be asked to pay a fee of \$5 that will be donated to Careflight.
- Nominations are not refundable when cancellations are made with in seven (7) days of the commencement of
 the draft, except under extenuating circumstances at the discretion of the committee, a refund applied, and a \$20
 cattle levy retained by the committee.
- All riders under 18 years of age MUST wear approved helmets whilst riding on the grounds (refer to Rule 19 of CCA General Rules and Guidelines – Children under 8 years of age are not allowed in the arena whilst an event is in progress – Exception to rule is mini's competing in event. Under no circumstances are children under the age 17 of permitted to ride/handle stallions within the perimeter of the grounds
- All stallions to be contained on the grounds as per CCA rule 11.12
- Jandowae Campdraft Association reserves the right to alter or amend the program in any way whatsoever & reserves the right to refuse entries without reason.
- All competitors compete at their own risk.
- In all cases the Judge's decision will be final.
- Any competitors who, in the opinion of the Executive Committee and/or Chief Steward, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and participating in any further events on the program & no refund of nomination will be offered.
- All prizemoney exclude GST & will be paid as per CCA rule 24 by direct deposit following the event.
- Dogs must either be excluded from the event or kept on a leash or securely tied up at all times. On all campdraft grounds owners of loose/unattended dogs are eligible for a fine or disqualification, or both.
