If a competitor withdraws less than 168hrs (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning on the program, then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee.

Conditions of Entry

- Any draw requests may be considered by the committee if written on the nomination form. Once draw is finalised there will be no changes made and all horses are to be run as drawn order in draft.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter the program or cancel any event at any time and their decision will be final.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time.
- Judges' decision in all cases will be FINAL.
- All riders Under 18yrs MUST wear approved helmets while riding on the grounds (refer to Rule 19 of CCA General Rules and Guidelines)
- Helmets must comply with current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin at all times. All riders compete at their own risk.
- Any competitors who, in the opinion of the Executive Committee and/or Chief Steward, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and also from participating in any further events on the program. No refund of nominations will be offered
- Rider restrictions – 8 runs/competitor maximum. The status of a horse winning a Campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest-class horse participating (eg. If one Open horse competes then it is an Open draft.)

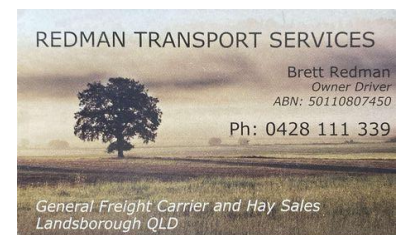

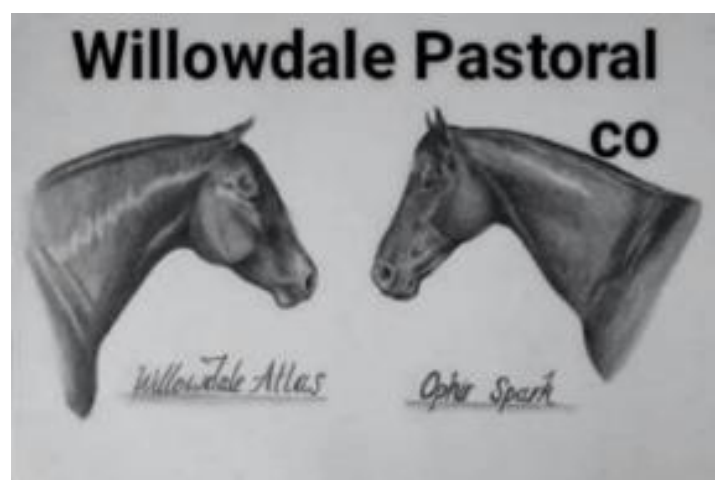
