2024 Dingo Campdraft - Rules and Stipulations

Prize Money: Paid as per ACA rule R.6 and R.9; used for percentages

Scratchings: 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 7 days prior to 6AM on Friday the 24th of May. If the competitor withdraws less than 7 days before this time, the entire nomination may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply then a refund may be granted; each case is at the discretion of the committee. **Helmets:** riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events.

Medical Services: provided by the Duaringa Ambulance Service.

Complaints: Any competitors wishing to lodge a complaint must do so in writing to the secretary within one hour of the incidence taking place. A \$100 fee must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$100 is forfeited.

Stallions: All stallions must be contained as per NCCA rule; stallions must not be ridden by anyone under 17 years of age.

Run Restrictions: 10 first round runs per competitor

Programme Altering: The committee reserves the right to alter the programme at any time

ACA rules: all riders compete at their own risk and must adhere to ACA rules; Judges Decision is Final.

ACA: ACA requires all competitors to ensure all details mirror those of their ACA member & horse profiles across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.

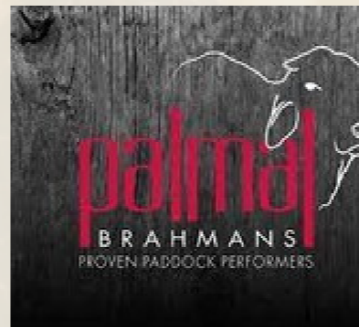
Horse Status: the status of the horse winning a Campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exemption of junior, juveniles, ladies.

Limited camping area and power: generators will NOT be supplied; please be respectful of the amount of area you occupy.
