CONDITIONS

1. All Competitors must be financial Australian Campdraft Association Inc (ACA) Members or approved Committee Volunteers.
2. Nominations open on 11th March at 7am and close on 12th March 2024 at 7am and must be lodged online via www.campdraftcentral.com.au
3. Horses names in the order they are to run must be stated when nominating and can't be changed after the close of nominations.
4. Electronic Fund Transfer: Account Name – Eidsvold Rodeo Committee Inc; BSB No. 084 838; Account No. 56 780 3330.
5. **The Committee reserves the right to –**
 - (a) **alter vary or cancel any part of the program** [including the maximum number of first round runs for each competitor]; and
 - (b) **refuse any nomination; and**
 - (c) **restrict each competitor to a maximum of eight (8) first round runs.**
6. Nominations refundable in full only if cancelled prior to 8am on Saturday, 23rd March 2024, as per ACA rule D.5.

D.5 Refunds applicable to scratching's: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program than the entire nomination fee may be retained by the Committee. If the Committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the Committee.
7. HORSE'S STATUS: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
8. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint must lodge the complaint in writing plus a fee of \$20 in cash with the Secretary within one hour of the incident taking place.
9. Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
10. Riders under 13 years are unable to ride in Open age events.
11. It is a condition of accepting a nomination that no competitor and horse owner, their executors, administrators or beneficiaries shall be entitled to make any claim demand or charge of any nature whatsoever against the Eidsvold Rodeo Committee Inc, the North Burnett Regional Council and the Australian Campdraft Association Inc or the members of such committees for any loss, accident injury or damage which may be suffered by such competitor or horse owner, their equipment or animals during the course of the program of events.
12. In the event of an EI or other outbreak all costs and obligations will be the responsibility of the horse owner.
13. Prize Money may not be paid at the event.
14. Stallions must be restrained in accordance with the National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) Rule 11.12.
15. At all times, persons present at the venue (i.e. the Eidsvold Showgrounds) shall abide by any request made by the Committee.
16. Unless approved by the Committee, no riders are to be in the Arena when events are being run.
17. All competitors and spectators must abide by the COVID requirements set by Queensland Health at the time of competition. Failure to follow directions of the Committee will see offenders disqualified from the competition and asked to leave the grounds immediately.
18. Photography and Social Media: competitors and spectators are requested to be mindful of images captured and shared on social media and ensure they are published with honourable intentions to the sport.
