Conditions of entry

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. The committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program at any time.

2. Program is ACA affiliated & run in accordance with "General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines

3. Horses to be nominated in order in which they are to be ridden.

4. All competitors compete **AT THEIR OWN RISK**. Each competitor must acknowledge that it is a condition of acceptance of their nomination that Pittsworth & District Campdraft Assoc Inc. will not be responsible for any injury, loss or damage.

5. All competitors limited to **ONE horse or rider change**.

6. Any changes need to be 1 hour prior to the commencement of Draft .

7. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$50 is forfeited

VERIFICATION "Financial Committee Member" is a member of P&DC Assoc Inc as at 1 July 2023.
The Judge's decision is FINAL in all Drafts.

10. SCRATCHINGS: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7days) prior to 8am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hrs (7days) prior to 8am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuation circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.

11. Biosecurity Horse Health Declaration must be presented to the Secretary's office – Please print ready – NO HEALTH DEC NO RUN - SHOWGROUNDS PIC: QEPW0235

12: Prize Money paid according to ACA Rules R.7 & R.9

13. The Status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse with exception Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts. The Winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating eg if an Open Horse competes then it is classed as an Open Draft

14. Stallion Containment requirements as per NCCA Rule 11.12

15. Nominations will be ONLY accepted via CAMPDRAFT CENTRAL – Only current ACA members can nominate, noncurrent nominations will be scratched if advised as non-current by ACA.

16. NO JUNIOR OR JUVENILE TO NOMINATE IN THE MAIDEN DRAFTS

17. Juvenile/Junior: Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and Juniors (8 years to under 13 years)

18. <u>HELMETS Riders under the age of 18 MUST</u> wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACAaffiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian & New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.

19. This event is run in accordance with COVID-19 requirements, current at the time of the event. Individual attendees are responsible for their own compliance with State vaccination requirements and movement directives.

NO DOGS ARE PERMITTED ON THE GROUNDS

If you don't adhere you shall be asked to leave the event and your nominations fortified. OR TYING HORSES TO TREES OR FENCES - DISPOSE/REMOVE BAILING
