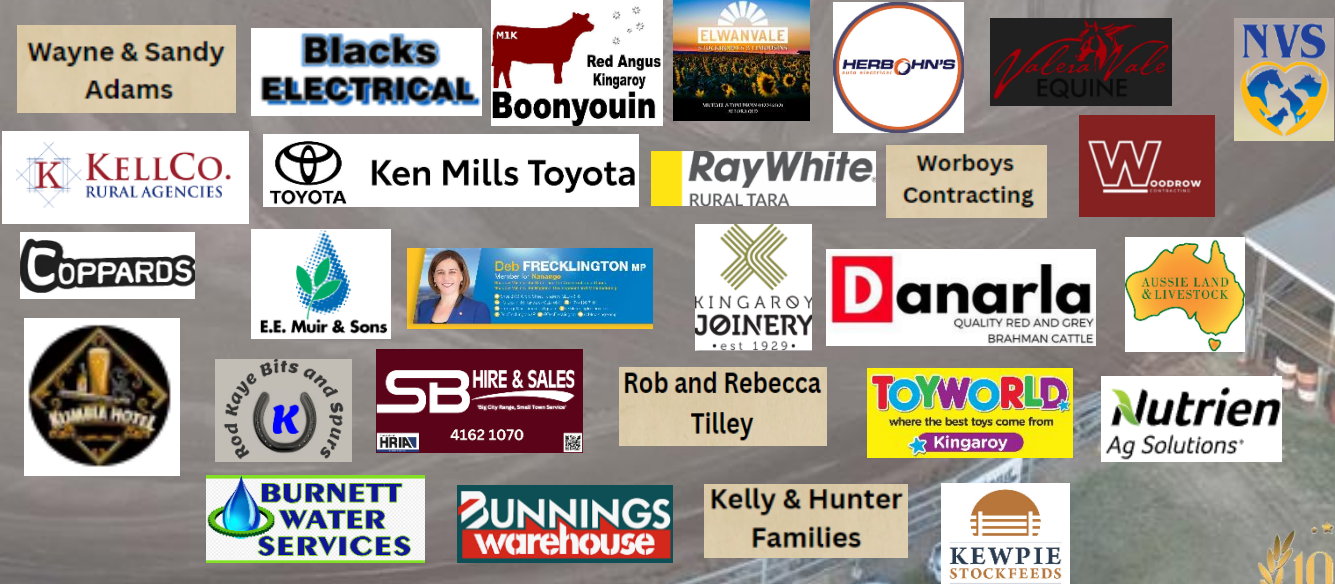

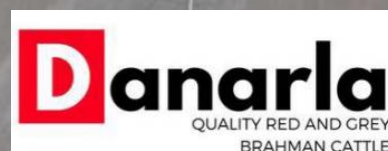

- Full payment for nominations must be received via EFT/Direct transfer by Friday 17th May at 4pm. Unpaid nominations will be cancelled after this date
- Direct Deposit as per Campdraft Central Invoice.
- All prize money payouts as per ACA Guidelines R 9
- All prize money refunds paid via Direct debit, competitors please ensure your bank details are recorded and correct on Campdraft Central
- The Committee will manage nominations as per ACA guidelines

Conditions

- All horses to remain on the inside of the racetrack. A Minimum \$1000 fine for anyone found damaging the golf greens (inside or outside of grounds) – Please keep clear at all times
- All competitors ride at their own risk and must be ready to compete when called
- No Juniors & Juveniles in Open & Restricted Open Drafts
- The Kumbia and District Charity Campdraft Association Inc. Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program in any way
- Program is ACA affiliated & run in accordance with the ‘General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines’
- SCRATCHING: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee
- HORSE STATUS - The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Futurity, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
- Any horse or rider changes made after the draws are complete will only be able to be changed along with a \$5 donation to a charity selected by the committee.
- Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- STALLIONS: All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules
- ACA requires all Competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.
- COMPLAINTS: “Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited.
