Nominations

Nominations will be via Campdraft Central for 24 hours.

Nominations will open Thursday 18th April 6am.

Restrictions may be put in place based on the number of nominations.

Payment due Wednesday 24th April 12pm.

Unpaid nominations on the 29th April will be scratched.

SCRATCHINGS received prior to 8am 26th April will receive a full refund. Scratching's between 26th-29th April will forfeit a \$15 stock levy. Scratching's received after 8am Monday 29th will not be refunded unless in extenuating circumstances.

Futurity Drafts are open to horses 4yrs and under that have not competed outside a futurity draft. Proof of registration or Vet Certificate is required for non-recognised AQHA or ASHS horses. ASHS Futurity Draft horses must be ASHS registered and hold a competition 'eligible' status. Riders must also be financial ASHS members. ASHS horses can nominate in **ONE** Futurity event only at the competitor's choice. The ASHS is insuring the ASHS Futurity.

Terms & Conditions

Program is ACA Affiliated and run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines'.

- NO POWER ON SITE
- The organising committee reserves the right to change the program without notice, cancel events and apply further restrictions to first round runs should nominations exceed cattle numbers.
- ACA rules apply.
- Any competitor that wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated event must lodge the complaint in writing to the secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee the \$100 is forfeited.
- The status of a horse winning a Campdraft will be determined by the highest class of the horse with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Drafts. The winner attains the status of the highest-class horse participating. E.g. if ONE Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open Draft.
- The horses 'status' will be as at the beginning of each draft at the fixture. Rule 9.9
- ALL STALLIONS must be contained as per NCCA rule 11.12.
- Juvenile/Junior: Juvenile (13yrs to under 17yrs), Junior (8yrs to under 13yrs)
- Under no circumstances is anyone under the age of 17yrs, permitted to ride/handle stallions within the parameters of the grounds.
- ENCOURAGEMENT DRAFT: an encouragement draft competitor shall be 17yrs and over who has not won 1 encouragement draft or won 1 open age draft or placed 3 times in an open aged draft.
- Riders under the age of 18yrs must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events at all times. Helmets must comply with the current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- The committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any person to compete on the Branch organised events.
- To be eligible for LOCAL events, riders must live within the 200km radius of Powlathanga Station.
- **All dogs on the grounds must be always either be tied-up or on leads. No dogs permitted in the spectator's area.**
- ALL CHILDREN competing in the horse sports must be financial members of the ACA. Helmets must be worn whilst mounted on a horse.
- COVID-19 management plan is in place. All officials, volunteers, competitors & spectators must abide by it.
- **ACA requires all Competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.**

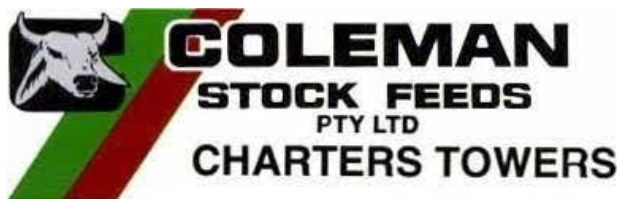
