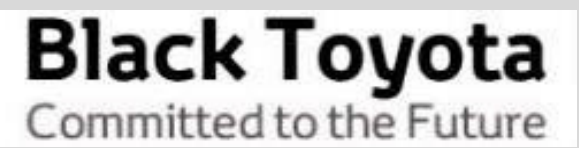
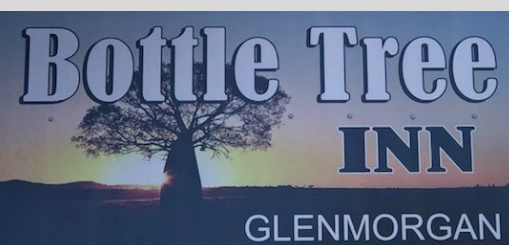
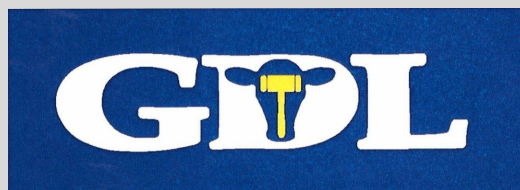

The Glenmorgan Rodeo & Campdraft Inc. would like to take this opportunity to thank all Sponsors, Cattle Donors, Transport Operators and anyone else who has helped in anyway to ensure that our Draft remains a success.

CONDITIONS:

1. AFFILIATION: Events are ACA Affiliated. Every person who competes at an ACA affiliated Draft must now be a full member of the Association.
2. ACA requires all Competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.
3. HELMETS: Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
4. SCRATCHING: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
5. HORSE'S STATUS: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
6. NOMINATION: Your ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed. Nominations must be paid in full for entries to be accepted. Nominations will be split evenly between the two Maiden and Novice Drafts.
7. ENCOURAGEMENT: An Encouragement campdraft competitor shall be 17 years and over and one who has not won 1 Encouragement or 1 Open age draft, or placed 3 times in an Open age campdraft.
8. FUTURITY: The definition of a Futurity Draft is for horses four years and under.
9. JUVENILE/JUNIOR: Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and Juniors (8 years to under 13 years).
10. COMPLAINTS: "Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited".
11. MEMBERSHIP: No ACA casual memberships are available.
12. STALLIONS: All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules.
13. Prize money will be paid to 6 places in all drafts. Prize money is allocated as per ACA guideline R.8 & R.9.
14. The committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program depending on number of nominations received and the availability of stock.
15. All competitors compete at their own risk.
16. Eight (8) first round starts per competitor.
17. Any horse or rider changes across the weekend must be in writing to the secretary.
