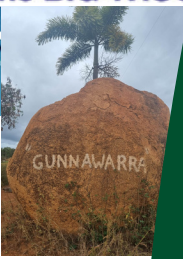

Any horse 5-year-old prior to August 1 will become a 6-year-old on August 1 and is not eligible to compete in the Classic Challenge that calendar year.

All registered horses must have their breed society registration papers available for inspection by committee. All unregistered horses must be inspected by the committees appointed representative to determine the age and eligibility to compete.

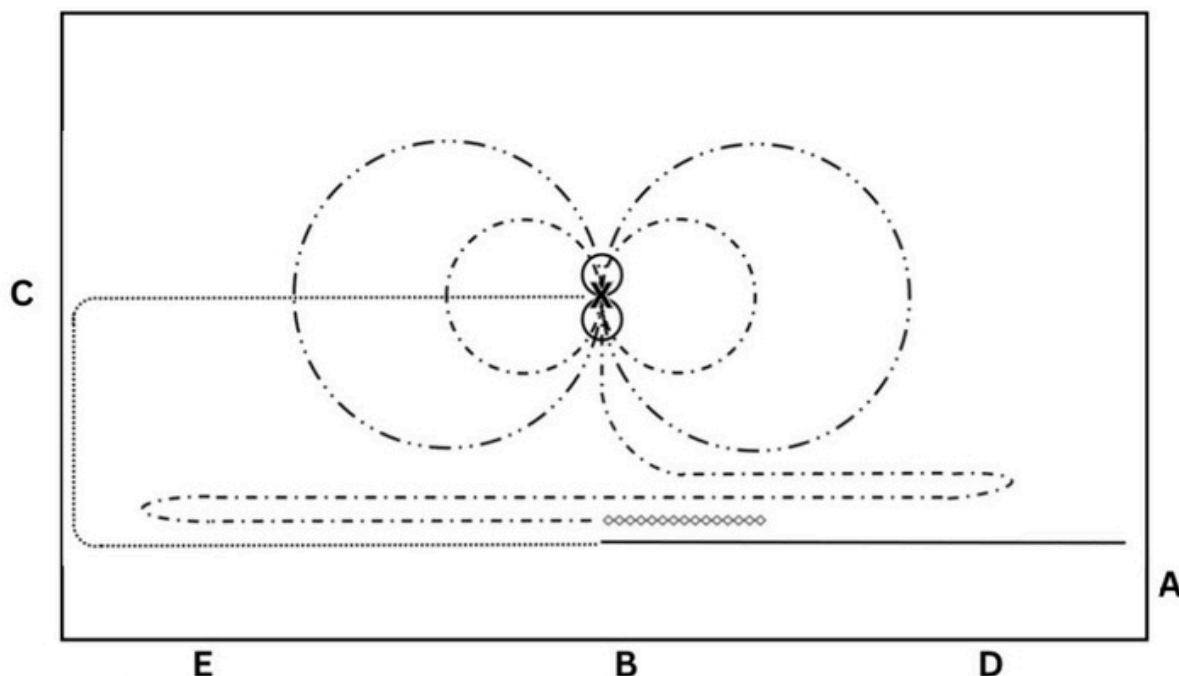

ASCA PATTERN #22



- 1 At A salute Judge & walk to B on loose rein cracking whip

- 2 At B trot with a degree of collection to C turning down centre line to X stop

- 3 Two spins to the left

- 4 Two and 1/4 spin to the right

- 5 Canter small slow circle to the right through X Canter large fast circle to the right

- 6 At X Flying Change

- 7 Canter large fast circle to the left. Canter Slow small circle to the left and continue through centre to D

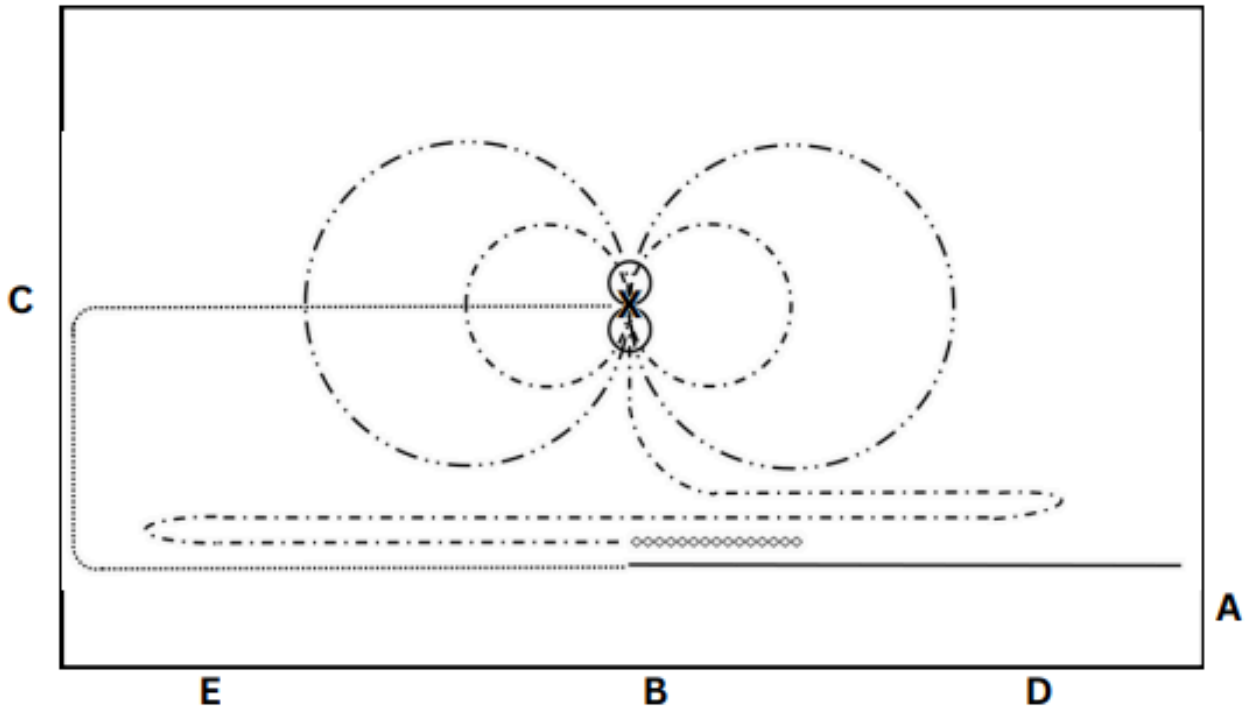
- 8 Stop at D & without hesitation rollback to the right

- 9 Canter to E stop and rollback to the left

- 10 Canter past B, stop, settle and back up to B. Salute Judge and leave arena on loose rein

Preliminary Pattern - Juvenile & Junior

ASCA PATTERN #24



- 1 At A, stand and crack whip 3 times. Then walk to B on loose rein

- 2 At B trot with a degree of collection to C turning down centre line to X stop

- 3 1 spins to the left

- 4 1 and 1/4 spin to the right

- 5 Canter small slow circle to the right through X Canter large fast circle to the right

- 6 At X Flying Change

- 7 Canter large fast circle to the left. Canter Slow small circle to the left and continue through centre to D

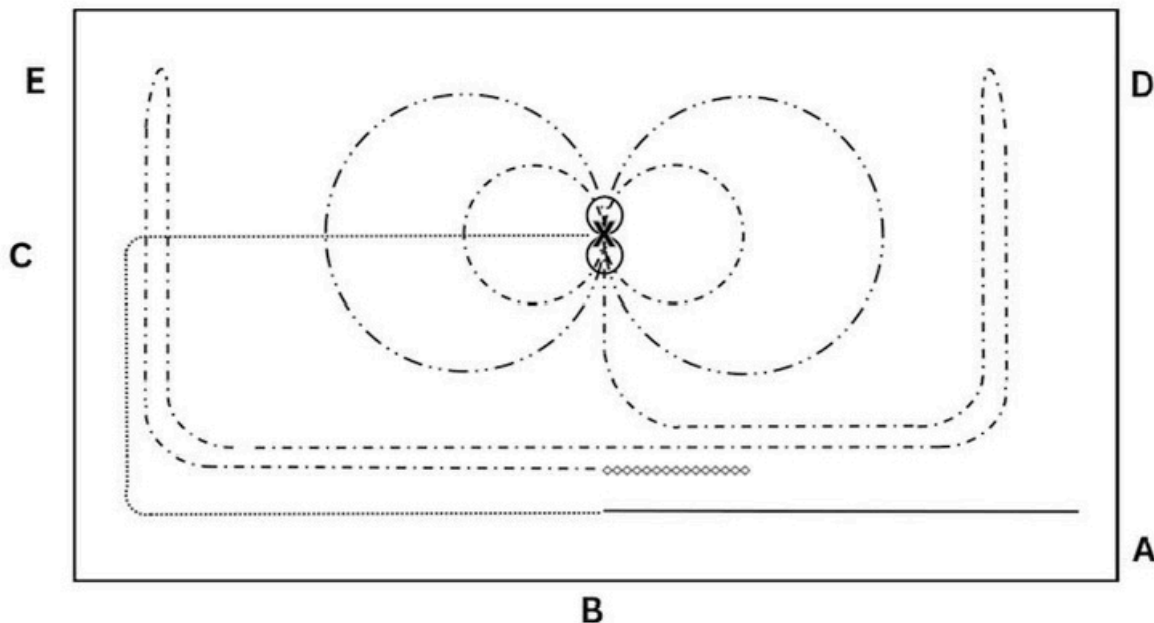
- 8 Stop at D & without hesitation rollback to the right

- 9 Canter to E stop and rollback to the left

- 10 Canter past B, stop, settle and back up to B. Salute Judge and leave arena on loose rein

Finals Pattern - Open, Derby, Classic & Rookie

- 1 At A salute Judge & walk to B cracking whip 3 times to show acceptance _____
- 2 At B trot with a degree of collection to C turning down centre line. Stop at X _____
- 3 Two spins to the left _____
- 4 Two and 1/4 spin to the right _____
- 5 Canter small slow circle to the right with flying change at X _____
- 6 Canter small slow circle to the left. Canter large fast circle to the left. Flying change at X _____
- 7 Canter large fast circle to the right with flying change at X _____
- 8 Canter around to D. Stop and roll back to the right. _____
- 9 Canter around to E. Stop and rollback to the left. Canter past B _____
- 10 Stop past B and settle and back up at least 3 metres. Leave the arena on a loose rein. _____
