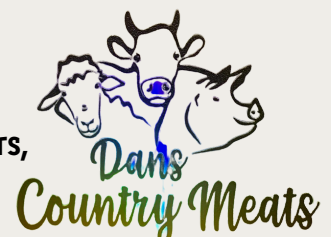

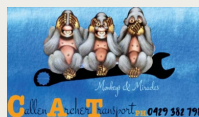

NOMINATIONS OPEN Wed 22nd MAY 2024 @ 8am via Campdraft Central for a 24hr period www.campdraftcentral.com.au Full payment to be received by Wed 29th of May 2024 or the nominations will be scratched.

Full refund if scratchings are received by Friday 31st of May 2024. A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 6.00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 6.00am on the first morning of the program, then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Program is ACA Affiliated & run-in accordance with the "General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines"

AFFILIATION: Events are ACA Affiliated.

- **MEMBER & HORSE DETAILS:** ACA requires all Competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.
 - **MEMBERSHIP:** No ACA casual memberships are available
 - Riders must be ACA members to ride and compete in Sutherland Park Campdraft facilities. It is a condition of entry at all ACA affiliated campdrafts that each and every competitor in campdraft events accepts the total and absolute personal responsibility for the risks involved during such event. Any 'unfinancial' member that compete will be referred to the Code of Conduct Sub-Committee.
 - **COVID-19 AWARE:** Please do not participate or enter the Equestrian Centre grounds if you are unwell.
 - **RESTRICTIONS:** Limited to 10 first round runs (excluding Futurity)
 - **PRIZE MONEY:** Will be paid in accordance with ACA rules & guidelines. Rules R8 & R9. No prizemoney will be paid out on the weekend. All prizemoney paid out through Campdraft Central, please ensure your correct bank account details are entered.
 - Juveniles wishing to incur points in a Maiden, Novice or Open draft must pay adult membership.
 - **HELMETS:** Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA-affiliated events, in and around the Equestrian Centre. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. .
 - **NOMINATION:** Your ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed
 - **COMPLAINTS:** Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited".
 - **SCRATCHING:** A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program, then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
 - **HORSES STATUS:** The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and New Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
 - **ENCOURAGEMENT:** An Encouragement campdraft competitor shall be 17 years and over and one who has not won 1 Encouragement or 1 Open age draft, or placed 3 times in an Open age campdraft.
 - **FUTURITY:** The definition of a Futurity Draft is for horses four years and under. Proof of age is required -vet certificate or registration papers.
 - **JUVENILE/JUNIOR/MINI:** Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and Juniors (8 years to under 13 years) and Mini (under 8 years).
 - **STALLIONS:** All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.11 of the ACA Rules.
 - Under no circumstances are riders to ride under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
 - The Sutherland Park Campdraft Committee. does not accept any responsibility/liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, beasts and spectators or property whatsoever.
 - Camping space and power is limited - please BYO generator. Please be mindful when marking your area.
 - Pre-erected fences will be removed!
- The Sutherland Park Campdraft Committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time without notice or reason and also reserves the right to restrict nomination.
