REGULATIONS

All prizemoney will be paid as per ACA guidelines R.9 (a2 & b) – Exempt our HHH PARTNERS DASH FOR CASH \$100,000 OPEN CAMPDRAFT.

Pay to 6th place unless stated otherwise on the program.

Trophy and ribbons for all drafts.

MEDICAL SERVICE PROVIDER: Springsure QAS

The committee reserves the right to alter delete any events on the program.

Competitors ride at their own risk and to ACA Rules.

1. HELMETS: Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times
2. SCRATCHINGS: A 100% refund of nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 6:30am on the first day of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 6:30am on first morning of competition then the entire fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
3. HORSE STATUS: The status of a horse winning an event will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes in that event with the exception of juniors, juveniles, ladies, mens, old buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class horse participating (eg if one open horse competes then it is classed as an open draft)
4. NOMINATIONS: Your ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed.
5. JUVENILE/JUNIOR: Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and junior (8years to under 13 years)
6. COMPLAINTS: Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary of the host committee within 1 hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with your complaint if the complaint is dismissed by the committee the \$100 is forfeited.
7. MEMBERSHIP: No ACA casual memberships are available.
8. MEMBER & HORSE DETAILS: ACA requires all competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms
9. STALLIONS: All stallions must be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules
