

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Program is ACA affiliated and run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines"
- 6 first round runs per Competitor Limit
- Nominations open Tuesday 20th August 2024 at 7am for 24 hours via website https:\\www.campdraftcentral.com.au
- Nomination Payments Due Tuesday 3rd September 2024. Unpaid nominations will be scratched.
- Prizemoney as per ACA Rules, B.5, R.6 R.9
- Medical Services Supplied by Hest Paramedical
- All competitors must be current 2024 financial members of the ACA.
- Nominations will be limited and numbers are restricted to the first fully paid first round nominations received.
- · Horses to be nominated in order of which horses are to be ridden.
- · Scratchings received within seven days of the draft will forfeit a \$10 fee.
- Any horse/rider changes requested during the weekend will require completion of a change form and incur a \$5 CASH ONLY Fee. Strictly no changes will be accepted after the event has commenced.
- Scratchings received after Wednesday 4th September 2024 will forfeit the whole nomination amount, unless there are extenuating circumstances.
- Campdraft competitors must hold themselves ready to compete at the advertised starting time on the day of draft. If the competitor fails to appear nomination fees paid or due shall be forfeited to the Hannaford Campdraft Committee.
- All competitors compete at own risk.
- · All prize money listed is GST inclusive.
- Refunds and prize money will be paid out by direct deposit following the event. To receive payment promptly competitors are requested to ensure their current banking details are provided on Campdraft Central.
- Per ACA rule B5 (e) Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a
 horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New
 Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
 Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets in the main arena.
- The committee reserves the right to alter the program without notice.
- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited.
- The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes will the exception of Mini, Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft)
- Member & Horse Details: ACA requires all competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non 'Campdraft One' platforms
