Conditions of Entry

ALL HORSES ARE TO BE RUN AS DRAWN ORDER IN DRAFT. NO CHANGES TO THE DRAW WILL BE MADE AFTER 60MINS PRIOR TO THE START OF EACH DRAFT.

All nominations to be submitted through Campdraft Central. No nominations accepted over the phone or by email. No cash nominations will be accepted.

The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries without reason.

The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program at any time.

No Juniors may nominate in the Maiden/Novice or Open events.

Horses are to be nominated in order in which horses are to be ridden.

A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than seven (7) days prior to 8 am on the first morning on the program.

If a competitor withdraws less than seven (7) days prior to 8 am on the first morning on the program, a \$20 fee will be forfeited per nomination.

Nominations fees refunded only if competitors or horses are injured and if approved by the Committee. There will be a stock levy of \$20 on each scratching.

Any Competitor who, in the opinion of the Management Committee, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and from participating in any further events on the program. No refund of nominations will be offered.

Campdraft competitors must hold themselves ready to compete. Three calls will be made for competitors. If the competitor fails to appear, nomination fees paid shall be forfeited to the Committee.

The Committee will not be responsible for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horse, rider, spectator or any other person or property whatsoever. Competitors ride at their own risk. Judge's decision in all cases will be final.

Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint, must lodge the complaint in writing within one (1) hour of the incident occurring. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$50 is forfeited.

All riders UNDER 18yrs must wear approved helmets when on a horse on the grounds, regardless of whether they are competing or not. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.

Under no circumstances are riders under the age of 17, permitted to ride/handle stallions within the perimeter of the grounds.

Stallion Containment Requirements as per Rule 11.12 of CCA General Rules and Guidelines Highest Scoring Lady Rider prizes - Lady rider competitor is 17 years and over.

Highest Scoring Local Rider prize - competitor must reside in postcode 4314.

NO Glass/Alcohol permitted to be brought onto the grounds.

Dogs must be always kept on a leash and/or be kept securely tied up whilst on the grounds.

First Aid Officers will be on the grounds all weekend.

Horse Health Declaration must accompany horses when travelling. Declaration must be completed and presented to the Secretary's office on arrival.

Waivers must be signed by all competitors and returned to the Nominations Secretary. No waiver, no ride.
