

FREE Competitors sausage sizzle on Thursday night. Bar and Pippy's Party Music Friday and Saturday night. A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.

ACA requires all Competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms. The committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time. Judges decision is final. Entry fee includes \$20 stock levy. ACA Event memberships are available and to be selected with nominations. All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules. Your ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed. Bar and food van facilities are available through-out the weekend. Due to the event being conducted on a showground NO Round Bales can be used. All manure to be piled up where it can easily be collected, NOT around trees or fences. Failure to do so will result in unsuccessful nominations the following year. Please DO NOT tape trees into horse yards, or tie horses to trees. The Armidale Campdraft Club Inc is not registered for GST. Riders under the age of 18 years must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA-affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current AUS/NZ safety standards and <u>must be securely fastened under the chin at all times</u>. All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program. All prizemoney to be paid as per ACA guidelines R6, R7, R8 and R9. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be paid when the complaint is lodged. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited. Horse's Status: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).


