TERMS AND CONDITIONS

HELMET RULE: Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all CCA-affiliated events. SCRATCHING RULE: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
