- 1. All drafts will be run under current CCA rules. Program is CCA Affiliated and run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules and Guidelines.
- 2. All competitors ride at their own risk and must be ready to compete as per draw or when called.
- 3. Any dispute will be settled by the Yarraman Wild Horse Campdraft Committee.
- 4. Any competitor who wished to lodge a complaint must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. if the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$50 fee is forfeited.
- 5. Riders under the age of 18 Years must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all CCA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- 6.Under no circumstances are members under 17 years of age permitted to ride stallions within the perimeter of the grounds
- 7. The committee reserves the right to alter, add or eliminate from the program.
- 8. Nominate Horses in order you wish to ride them.
- 9.NO CHANGING OF HORSES OR RIDERS 60 MIN PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE DRAFT (a fee of \$10 will be charged if a change is made after this and donated to a local charity of the committees choosing)
- 10.The committee may ask competitors to shorten up yard sizes so as more trucks can fit in.
- 11. Nominating for the draft deems that the competitors have read and understood the conditions.
- 12. Refunds applicable to scratchings: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8.00am on the first morning of the program, then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
- 13. No Camping on Road. Please stay within the grounds.
- 14. All Stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule CCA rule 11.12 page 13 & 14
- 15. Judges decision is final in all cases.
- 16.The Yarraman Wild Horse Committee has the right to refuse competitors nominations
- 17. Any competitors who, in the opinion of the Executive Committee and/or Chief Steward, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and fromparticipating in any further events on the program. No refund of nominations will be offered
- 18. All dogs must be always kept on a leash and/or be kept securely tied up whilst on the grounds
