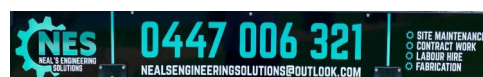

~ Conditions of Entry ~

All competitors ride at their own risk and must be ready to compete when called.

Any dispute will be settled by the Widgee Campdraft Committee.

Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$20 is forfeited.

Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse during the event. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.

The committee has the right to alter, add or eliminate any event from the program.

The committee may ask competitors to shorten up yard sizes so more trucks can fit in.

Nominating for the draft deems that the competitors have read, accepted & understood the conditions.

A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 7 days prior to 8 am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 7 days prior to 8 am on the first morning of the program, then the entire nomination fee may be retained at the discretion of the Committee. If the Committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the Committee.

If the event is canceled, all nominations will be refunded in full.

8 runs per competitor for the event.

Horse Health Declarations MUST be provided before competing.

The number of nominations accepted is subject to the availability of cattle.

The committee reserves the right to refuse entries without any reason.

No changes to the draw will be made after the start of the draft.

All competitors compete AT THEIR OWN RISK. Each competitor must acknowledge that it is a condition of acceptance of their nomination that the Widgee District Hall & Recreation Assoc. Inc. will **NOT** be responsible for any injury, loss or damage.

The Judges decision is final.

Gympie Volunteer First Aid Services Inc. will be in attendance.

Admission to the grounds is free.

At the Committee's discretion, any competitor mistreating stock in any way will be excluded from competing any further for the entire event. The committee reserves the right to cancel or alter any event or close nominations early, depending on number of nominations received and the availability of stock.

2. All vehicles and equipment accompanying the horses will be in a clean condition at the start of travel to the event.
3. The information contained in this Horse Health Declaration is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
4. I have read the Conditions of Entry & agree to abide by all conditions and directions of the Organising Committee.
5. I acknowledge that failure to comply with the above may result in refusal of entry to the venue or disqualification as decided by the Organising Committee.
6. In the event of horse movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horses/s including feeding and watering.
