- All riders Under 18yrs MUST wear approved helmets while riding on the grounds (refer to Rule 19 of CCA General Rules and Guidelines)
- Under no circumstances are members under the age of 17yrs permitted to ride/handle stallions within the perimeter of the grounds
- If required, Horse Health Declarations must accompany horses when travelling. Declaration must be completed and presented to the Secretaries office upon arrival
- Any competitors who, in the opinion of the Executive Committee and/or Chief Steward, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and also from participating in any further events on the program. No refund of nominations will be offered.
- All dogs must be always kept on a leash and/or be kept securely tied up whilst on the grounds.

Lathan's Story

MIDDLEMOUNT CAMPDRAFT 2025

Campdraft 4 A Cause

For 2025 the Middlemount Rodeo Association Inc has decided that we will be holding our annual Campdraft with Lathan as our major beneficiary & hope that we can raise some much needed funds to help Lathan & his family make it to the end of his treatment. Lathan's mum Rhiannon Curran was secretary for a number of years with her family being involved in the club for many years. Her Grand Parents, Tom & Pam were some of the founding members alongside her dad, Jim & his brothers, with his family today still involved. So for 2025 we invite you to support our Campdraft & ride for Lathan.

Lathan is the son of Rhiannon Curran & Trent Searle who alongside her twin sister Layne was born prematurely at just 26 weeks. This pair of little fighters battled their way through 100 plus days in NICU at Townsville Hospital to make it home safe & sound finally to begin normal life as all babies should.

Lathan & Layne began to thrive at home in Ayr with their parents & two older sisters, Maddison & Ellanah. However, a sore shoulder in July of 2024 saw Lathan end up back in Townsville for scans to determine what was wrong. Whilst family thought this was a normal bump in any child's life. Rhiannon was faced with the unthinkable news that no parent wishes to hear while partner Trent was over 5 hours away in Central QLD for work. Lathan had Stage 4 High Risk Neuroblastoma Cancer.

Just shy of his 2nd birthday Lathan would be rushed to Brisbane 2 days after diagnosis for evaluation & treatment. His diagnosis would mean the best care would be in Brisbane & his family would be split as his treatment would involve months of chemotherapy, stem cells, radiation & immunotherapy. Whilst in a perfect world the family would all be together, the logistics of treatment & Lathan's safety, school & care for each of the kids & the bills needing to be paid had to be considered. This means Rhiannon is in Brisbane with Lathan full time, Trent is between work in Central QLD & the kids, Layne is with grand parents Jim & Janet Curran at Middlemount & the older girls are in Mackay with family, visiting when able & safe for Lathan.

Lathan has battled his way through 5 rounds of chemotherapy, major surgery to have the large tumours removed from his abdomen including his adrenal gland which is the source of the cancer, 1 round of stem cells & he begun his 2nd round of stem cells in early March. This little battler has been smashing goals & while his treatment still has a long road ahead. February saw a glimmer of hope for little Lathan with a scan completed before his second round of stem cells giving the best news yet! Treatment was working & the scan revealed no sign of disease. Whilst this is news for celebrating, Lathan must still endure the stem cells, radiation, immunotherapy & whatever else the doctors plan to ensure that he has the best chance of entering remission. So the funds raised at our 2025 Campdrsft will hopefully help this young family stay on their feet & see Lathan home for Christmas in 2025.
