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● CONDITIONS

- The Dalby & District Campdraft Club Inc. does not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, and spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- The committee reserves the right to change the program without notice.
- All competitors compete at their own risk.
- Judges' decision in all cases will be FINAL
- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited.
- Any competitors who, in the opinion of the Executive Committee and/or Chief Steward, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and also from participating in any further events on the program. No refund of nominations will be offered.
- Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all CCA affiliated events see rule 19 of CCA general rules and guidelines. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- Stallions must be restrained, under no circumstances are members under the age of 17yrs permitted to ride/handle stallions within the perimeter of the grounds
- The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one open horse competes then it is classed as an open draft).

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- To be eligible for additional prizes, all details must be provided at time of nomination.
- All prize monies paid as per CCA General Rules and Guidelines Section 24.
- SCRATCHING: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted, and \$20 cattle levy retained by the committee. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
- The showgrounds will open on Thursday morning and close on Sunday evening, camping at grounds outside this time may incur a camping fee imposed by WDRC. NO TAPE TO BE PUT UP UNTIL THURSDAY.
- All dogs must be always kept on a leash and/or be kept securely tied up whilst on the grounds

THERE WILL BE NO STABLING OF HORSES.

Due to council restrictions, we are unable to use the stables and fines will apply if horses are found within them.

Please note that unvaccinated horses may not be treated by our local vets.

Biosecurity Declarations and Horse Movements Records must be completed & submitted on arrival.

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In light of the recent detection of Hendra Virus in Queensland, the Department of Primary Industries (DPI) has emphasized the importance of Horse Health Declaration Forms for all equine events. As part of our ongoing efforts to ensure the safety and well-being of all horses and participants, the Western Downs Regional Council has requested that each competitor completes a Horse Health Declaration that lists every horse they have at the Campdraft, whether competing or not, between the 15th and 17th of August 2025.

These forms must be submitted to the Secretary's Office prior to the commencement of the draft. You may either submit the form via email or in person. Please be advised that there will be copies of the form available on the day for those who have not yet submitted one.

It is important to note that if a Horse Health Declaration is not presented to the Secretary's Office before your first run, the Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to the event.

DECLARATION BY OWNER OR PERSON IN CHARGE OF HORSE/S ATTENDING

I _____ declare that the horse/s named above has/have been in good health, eating normally and not shown signs of illness during the last 3 days leading up to this event. I give my authorisation for the Event Organising Committee/Manager to call for veterinary inspection of the horse/s named above and in my care should they be showing signs of illness at any time during the course of the event. I agree to pay any veterinary fees incurred for the above mentioned horse/s as a result of this veterinary examination.

I agree to ensure that:

1. All horses will be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry, and their hooves will be picked clean of all solid material and washed with shampoo.
2. All vehicles and equipment accompanying the horses will be cleaned to remove all solid material that could contain disease agents, and then disinfected.
3. As a Queensland horse owner, the procedures outlined in the Queensland Biosecurity Manual have been undertaken to reduce the risk of spreading cattle ticks and the horse/s are tick free.

I further declare that:

4. The information contained in this Biosecurity Declaration is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
5. I agree to abide by all conditions that may be imposed at any time by the Event Organising Committee/Manager.
6. I acknowledge that in failure to comply, I may be directed to leave and my nominations will be forfeited.
7. I acknowledge that decontamination and disinfection procedures may be required of me if instructed by the Event Organising Committee/Manager.
8. I acknowledge that there is a possibility that horses might become infected with disease agents as a result of any movements and if necessary horses and premises will be quarantined in accordance with any Legislation covering such occurrences including policies and procedures in effect at that time. I agree and acknowledge that the Manager/Event Organising Committee, it's State or National Affiliated bodies and their members are not in any way liable for any cost, expense, loss, damage, claim, action, proceeding or other liability incurred by or made against me as a result of any movement of horses to the Event.
