## **Dingo Rodeo Club Campdraft - Rules & Stipulations**

- Prize Money: Paid as per ACA rule R.6 and R.9; used for percentages.
- Scratchings: 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than
  7 days prior to 6AM on Thursday the 15th of May 2025. If the competitor withdraws less than 7 days
  before this time, the entire nomination may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems
  that extenuating circumstances apply then a refund may be granted; each case is at the discretion of
  the committee.
- Helmets: Riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA
  affiliated events.
- Medical Services: Provided by the Duaringa Ambulance Service.
- Complaints: Any competitors wishing to lodge a complaint must do so in writing to the secretary
  within one hour of the incident taking place. A \$100 fee must be lodged with the complaint. If the
  complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$100 is forfeited.
- Stallions: All stallions must be contained as per NCCA rule; stallions must not be ridden by anyone under 17 years of age.
- Run Restrictions: 10 first round runs per competitor.
- Program Altering: The committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time.
- ACA rules: All riders compete at their own risk and must adhere to ACA rules; Judges decision is final.
- ACA: ACA requires all competitors to ensure all details mirror those of their ACA member & horse profiles across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.
- Horse Status: The status of the horse winning a Campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exemption of Junior, Juveniles & Ladies.
- Limited Camping Area and Power: Generators will NOT be supplied; please be respectful of the amount of area you occupy.
- Services: Canteen and Bar will be operating; live entertainment Friday and Saturday night.
- Presentations: Will be held immediately after each event.
- · "All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program."




