4 First Round Runs

Nominations open 8 am Monday 28th April 2025 (24 hours only) www.campdraftcentral.com.au

#### All Competitors MUST add the CCA Event fee when nominating.

The committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time.

Rosewood Campdraft Association Inc does not accept responsibility for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horse, rider, spectator, or any person or property whatsoever.

SCRATCHINGS – A 100% fund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws from event more than 7 days (168 hours) prior to commencement of the first day of the draft. If competitor withdraws less than 168 hours, the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be given. Each scratching will be discretions of the committee.

- 1. All Horses to be nominated in the order you wish to ride.
- 2. Judges decision is FINAL.
- 3. All campdrafts are to be won outright.
- 4. Prize monies paid as per CCA General Rules and guidelines Section 24
- 5. Horses are to be run as drawn order in draft. No changes to the draws will be made after 1 hour prior to the start of each event.
- 6. All riders Under 18 MUST wear approved helmets while riding on the grounds (refer to Rule 19 of CCA General Rules and Guidelines)
- 7. Under no circumstances are competitors under the age of 17 years permitted to ride/handle stallions within the grounds of the Rosewood Showgrounds
- 8. All stallions are to be contained (refer to Rule 11.12 of CCA General Rules and Guidelines)
- 9. Any competitors who, in the opinion of the Executive Committee, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock, will be disqualified from the event and from participating from any further events on the program. No refunds of nominations will be offered.
- 10. Horse Health Declarations must accompany horses when travelling and presented to Secretary's office upon arrival. No Declaration, No ride.
- 11. Dogs must always remain on a leash while on grounds.
- 12. Stallion service fees are non-transferrable and not for resale.
