- Juvenile or junior competitors must NOT ride STALLIONS on the grounds at any time.
- All competitors must be ACA members.
- Casual members are accepted-please see ACA rules & regulations regarding all membership fees.
- ACA requires all Competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.
- The ASHOFCCI or ASHOF does not assume liability for accidents or injury to competitors, for their stock or loss/damage to their property, and each competitor by an act of entry or participation waiver all claims for injury, loss, damage that they, their helpers, their stock, or their property may sustain.
- Any competitor under the influence of liquor or drugs will be disqualified without recourse.
- Any competitor not present by the third call will be disqualified.
- Juniors may not compete in any other event. ACA Rule B.5(e) Riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet at all ACA affiliated events.
- Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- Stallions must be restrained as per ACA guidelines.
- Any competitor wishing to lodge a complaint must do so in writing within 1 hour of the incident and must be accompanied by a \$100 fee.
- The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates, and Encouragement Campdrafts.
- The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft.
- All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program.
