CONDITIONS - CCA RULES APPLY

AFFILIATION: Events are CCA Affiliated. HELMETS: All riders under the age of 18 years must wear properly fitted helmets (includes use of the chinstrap) that comply with current AS/NZS standards (3838) and are less than five years old from the date of manufacture. SCRATCHINGS: 100% refund on nomination fee will be given to competitors who withdraw 168 hrs (7 days) prior to 8am of the first morning of the program, if a competitor withdraws less than 168 hrs (7 days) then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee. Scratching's will incur a \$20 stock levy. NOMINATIONS: Campdraft committees may reserve the right to reject the entry of any competitor who has violated the general rules, who has been dishonest in competition or who has proven to be undesirable in any recognised draft. ENCOURAGEMENT: A rider 17 years and over. Has not won an Open age draft (i.e. Maiden, Novice, Open, Ladies, Associates) or a restricted draft as in 9.3 and 9.4.

A win will not alter the status of the horse. Competitors cease to be eligible to compte after winning one (1) encouragement, or one (1) open age Campdraft, or placing three (3) times in open age Campdraft. FUTURITY: The definition of a Futurity Draft is for horses Five (5) years and under; proof of age can be uploaded on Campdraft central- via Nominations-Horses. MINI/JUNIOR/JUVENILE: Mini (rider aged 5-7 years), Junior (a rider aged from 8 years and under 13 years) & Juvenile (a rider ages from 13 years and under 17 years). APPEALS/PROTESTS: Appeals and protests by any competitor on matters pertaining to a Campdraft in progress shall be heard by the committee conducting such Campdraft. If the competitor concerned is dissatisfied with the decision arrived at, he or she has the right of appeal in writing to the CCA Management Committee. STALLIONS: Under no circumstances are members under the age of 17 years permitted to ride/handle stallions within the perimeters of the grounds. To be contained in accordance with 11.12 of CCA General Information Rules and Recommendations KIDS HORSE SPORTS: Horse sports will be conducted by Nebo Pony Club on Saturday.
