


Competitors are limited to 6 first round Campdraft runs excluding the Futurity draft.

#### **TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

- 1.AFFILLIATION: Events are CCA Affiliated and run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines'.
- 2.MEMBERSHIP: Competitors must be financial ASHS members or Day Members to be eligible for High Point ASHS awards. Membership numbers and horse registration numbers must be included when nominating. All Challenge & Highest Scoring ASH competitors must be ASHS members or temporary members. \$50 for adult membership and \$20 for youth membership (under 18).
- 3.HELMETS: Competitors under 18 years of age must wear an equestrian helmet approved by the current Australian Standards Association or International equivalent, which must be securely fastened under the chin, when mounted anywhere within the perimeter of the grounds, including all public areas.
- 4. Prize Money: All prize money will be paid as pr CCA general rules and guidelines no. 24.
- 5.SCRATCHING: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor with draws less than 168hrs (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
- 6. JUVENILE/JUNIOR: Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and Juniors (8 years to under 13 years).
- 7. COMPLAINTS: "Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited".
- 8. STALLION: Confinement requirement refer to CCA Rule 11.12.
