- 1. Nominations will be VIA Campdraft Central and will open on Monday 18th August at 7am For 24hrs. Nominations must be lodged online at www.campdraftcentral.com.au
- 2. Payment will be required in full by Wednesday 27th August 4pm to secure your place.
- 3. Program is CCA affiliated & run in accordance with the CCA Rules & Guidelines, CCA Event of \$10inc, ALL competitors must add this event type when nominating via Campdraft Central
- 4. All competitors ride at their own risk and must sign a waiver and hand in a Horse Health Declaration to compete. PIC **QBWC0827**
- 5. Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all CCA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- 6. Nominating for the draft deems that competitors have read and understood the conditions.
- 7. A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor with draws more than 7 days prior to 8 am on the first morning of the program.
 - If a competitor withdraws less than 7 days prior to 8 am on the first morning of the program, then the entire nomination fee may be retained at the discretion of the Committee. If the Committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the Committee. If the event is cancelled, all nominations will be refunded in full
 - 8. Teebar Showgrounds are in a tick area. Competitors must arrange their own permits/spraying.
