All challenges are run under Australia Stockman's Challenge **Association** (ASCA) rules and regulations. It is mandatory that all competitors are current financial members of ASCA.

NO ASCA MEMBERSHIP - NO RIDE

Riders under 18 years of age must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse in and around the showgrounds. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. Payment must be received by 28th July 2025 - NO MONEY - NO NOMINATION

#### **CLASSIC CHALLENGE \$5,000 & BUCKLE**

Horses 4vrs & under. All Classic horses are eligible in this age event until the end of the ASCA Point Yr - ending in Sept 2025.

Limited Classic Challenge run in conjunction with the Classic Challenge. Champion will receive a rug donated by Newmarket Saddlery and Turner Signs Buckle sponsored by MABEN FAMILY. Limited Buckle sponsored by ASCA. Entry Fee: \$250 - First Round & Final

### OPEN CHALLENGE \$4,000 & BUCKLE Open to any horse and rider.

Novice run in conjunction with the Open Challenge.

Champion will receive a rug donated by Newmarket Saddlery and Turner Signs. Buckle sponsored by TARAWAY PARTNERSHIP.

> Combined Entry Fee: \$300 Novice only: \$100 and \$1,000 Prizemoney First Round & Final

#### **ROOKIE CHALLENGE \$3,000 & BUCKLE**

Restricted to riders who have never won a Classic, Derby, Novice or Open Challenge. Champion will receive a rug donated by Newmarket Saddlery and Turner Signs. Buckle sponsored by BENALLA STUD. Competitors who win a Rookie Challenge will remain eligible to compete in Rookie events for the remainder of the ASCA point year. As per rule 17.3 open to all horses.

Entry Fee: \$160 - First Round & Final

#### **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

Scratchings: All scratching's received before 9am Monday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2025 will be fully refunded. Scratching's received after that time and date will only be refunded at the committee's discretion.

All horses are allowed no more than one first round start per event.

Prize monies will be paid in accordance with ASCA rules and guidelines. No prize monies will be paid out during the event. All prize monies paid out through Campdraft Central, please ensure your bank account details are entered. The committee reserves the right to alter, change or delete any event at any time. Any competitor that wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft or Challenge must lodge the said complaint in writing to the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$50 is forfeited.

Competitors must adhere to the draw. Horses must be ridden in the order of the draw. Competitors can make a submission to change the draw prior to the event commencing at the Secretary's Office. No changes will be accepted after the start of the event.

All stallions must be contained as per ASCA ruling.

Neither the organising committee, Plainsman's Challenge, ASCA or ABCRA accept any liability for any accident, damage, loss or illness to horses, riders, beast or any person or property whatsoever.


#### **ASCA PATTERN #27 2025**



A B

- Salute Judge at A. Walk to B. Trot to X (centre). Stop
- 2 360 degree spin to the right
- 3 360 degree spin to the left
- 4 From X, canter a large circle to the right on the correct lead
- At X, do a simple change and canter a larger circle to the left on the correct lead
- 6 At X, do a simple change and canter to C
- (7) Stop and do a rollback to the left and canter to D
- 8 Stop and Do a rollback to the right and canter around past B
- 9 Stop, settle your horse, back your horse to the centre line. Stop
- Salute the judge and leave the arena on a looserein






Enter at A, canter to X. Stop, Settle

- 2 Spins to the left
- 3 2 and ¼ spins to the right.
- Gallop large fast circle to the left. Canter small slow circle to the left.
- 5 Flying Change at X
- 6 Canter small slow circle to the right. Gallop large fast circle to the right but do not close the circle.
- 7 Run down near B, stop and roll back to the left.
- 8 Run down near C, stop and roll back to the right.
- 9 Run down past the centre line. stop, settle and back up.
- Acknowledge Judge. Exit arena at a working walk cracking the whip on a loose rein.

- At A acknowledge judge and demonstrate horses acceptance of the whip. Trot to X. Stop at X
- 2 spins to the right
- 2 spins to the left
- Canter a small slow circle to the right, Gallop a large fast circle to the right.
- At X perform a flying lead change to the left.
- Gallop a large fast circle to the left and a small slow circle to the left.
- At X perform a flying lead change to the right
- Continue around arena at canter and run down and stop between the centre marker and B. Roll back to the left.
- Continue around arena at canter and run down and stop between the centre marker and C. Roll back to the Right.
- 10 Rundown past the centre marker, stop and back up at least 3m. Settle.
