CONDITIONS:

- Aggregate score is taken from the FIRST rounds ONLY from the FIVE venues.
- To qualify a horse must compete at ONE of the FIVE venues. Does NOT have to be ridden by the SAME rider at all five venues. Rider for shootout MUST have ridden the horse at ONE of the five venues.
- Shootout places paid on final ONLY, NOT aggregate scores. This means a clean slate to start the shootout.
- Will take at least 20 into the shootout, committee reserves the right to take more. If due to unforeseen circumstances and the shootout can't be held, 3 of the venues must run for there to be any places awarded & will be paid on aggregate score.





CONDITIONS.

- 1. The committee reserves the right to add, alter or delete any event from the program and reserves the right to disqualify for the whole of the Campdraft any competitor who nominates a horse in any event in which it is not entitled to compete and any competitor who mistreats his animals or attempts to compete whilst under the influence of alcohol or an illicit drug THE ST GEORGE CAMPDRAFT ASSOCIATION INC and its assistants will not accept responsibility for an accident, loss, injury or damage to competitors, persons stock or property either on grounds or during the course of the Campdraft. All nominations must be paid for before nominations will be accepted.
- 2. Please nominate horses in order in which they intend to compete.

ACA Terms & Conditions:

- 3. **AFFILIATION**: Events are ACA Affiliated & run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines'.'
- 4 **HELMETS:** Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA-affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- 5. **SCRATCHING:** A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
- 6. **HORSE'S STATUS:** The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
- **7. FUTURITY:** 'A Futurity campdraft is for horses aged up to a maximum of 5 years and under. A horse's age will be determined as at the 1st of August each year.'
- 8 JUVENILE/JUNIOR: Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and Juniors (8 years to under 13 years).
- 9. **Complaints:** ACA rule R12 'Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be paid when the complaint is lodged. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited.'
- 10.**Member & Horse Details:** ACA requires all Competitors to ensure all details: mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.'
- 11 **STALLIONS**: All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules Anyone not abiding by this rule will be asked to leave the grounds.
- 12. Casual Members: The St George Campdraft committee will be accepting casual ACA memberships .
- 13. Open Age Events Age Disclosure: All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program.
- 14. PLEASE NOTE ANY CHANGES TO BE MADE TO NOMINATIONS MUST BE MADE <u>1 HOUR PRIOR</u> TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THAT DRAFT <u>"NO EXCEPTIONS".</u> NO CHANGES AFTER THE DRAFT HAS STARTED.....AS PER ACA RULES YOU MUST RIDE YOUR HORSES IN DRAW ORDER IF FOUND TO BE RIDING THE WRONG HORSE <u>ALL</u> OF YOUR NOMINATIONS FOR THE WEEKEND WILL BE FORFIETED.


\$25 - Casual ACA Membership Fee. This is an annual membership type that allows members to nominate for events where casual memberships are accepted. Casual Membership can not be upgraded to another membership throughout the year.

How do I become a Casual Member if I don't have a Campdraft One profile?


- 1. To become a Casual Member of ACA if you do not yet have a Campdraft One account, visit the ACA website and find the New Member Application Form under the Contact Us tab or call the ACA Office during office hours to create a Campdraft One profile. PH: (07) 4622 3110.
- 2. Pay for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.

How do I become a Casual Member if I already have a Campdraft One profile?

- 1. Sign into your Campdraft One profile.
- 2. Go to 'My Profile'. Here you will see a blue banner directing you to pay your membership.



3. Select who you wish to pay the membership for, then select membership type, 'Casual Membership', select 'Check Out' and proceed to payment for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.



\$100 - Event Membership Fee: payable to the Committee once the nominations are accepted.

Now that I'm a Casual Member, what's next?

- 1. Once you are a Casual Member, you will be able to nominate for ACA affiliated events, where the committee is accepting Casual/Event Memberships (as advertised on the program).
- 2. If your nominations are accepted into an ACA affiliated event, you will then receive an invoice for the \$100 (GST inc.) Event Membership along with your nominations invoice.

Please note all ACA membership types are non-refundable.
