A Futurity campdraft is for horses aged up to a maximum of 5 years and under. A horse's age will be determined as at the 1st of August each year. Unregistered horses must be accompanied by a veterinarian certificate or accredited equine dentist stating the age of the horse, obtained at the owner's expense & must be submitted with nominations





















The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of $horse\ that\ competes\ with\ the\ exception\ of\ Juniors,\ Juveniles,\ Ladies,\ Men's,\ Old$ Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft)

- All invoices must be paid in full by 17th of September or you will be scratched no exceptions.
- Horses names must be entered in order of which they are to run, names are to be stated when nominating.
- All changes must be completed by the day before an event BEGINS. (Example Friday events changes need to be made by Thursday) Please respect our committee by doing your changes early.
- The Westmar Sports Club Campdraft Committee reserves the right to alter/amend or restrict the program in any way whatsoever and the committee's decision is final.
- Each Competitor must acknowledge that it is a condition of acceptance of their nomination that neither the Westmar Sports Club or the Western Downs Regional Council will be responsible in respect of injury, loss or damage.
- AFFILIATION: Program is ACA Affiliated & run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines.
- ACA requires all Competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms
- PRIZE MONEY: Paid out as per ACA Rules R.8 &R.9. Competitors, please ensure your bank details are recorded and correct.
- COMPLAINTS: Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary
 within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaints
 dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited.
- Scratching's: Nominations refundable in full only if cancelled prior to 7am on Friday the 20th of September 2025, as per ACA rule D.5. D.5 Refunds applicable to scratching's: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 7.00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 7.00am on the first morning of the program than the entire nomination fee may be retained by the Committee. If the Committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the Committee.
- All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program
- JUNIOR/MINI COMPETITORS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO RIDE IN ANY OTHER EVENT.
- Junior/Juveniles are not permitted to handle or ride stallions while on sports grounds.
- All riders under the age of 18 years must wear, properly fitted helmets (includes use of the chinstrap) that comply with current AS/NZS standards (3838) and are less than five years old from the date of manufacture.
- AN ENCOURAGEMENT CAMPDRAFT COMPETITOR SHALL BE 17 YEARS AND OVER AND ONE WHO HAS NOT WON 1
 ENCOURAGEMENT OR 1 OPEN AGE DRAFT OR PLACED 3 TIMES IN AN OPEN AGE CAMPDRAFT
- 8 FIRST ROUND RUNS (Excludes Ladies, Restricted Open, Stallion Drafts & Futurity). ACA RULE E1
- 2 Starts per horse (Excluding Ladies, Restricted Open, Stallion Draft, Children's Events)
- All stallions must be restrained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules.
- HORSE'S STATUS: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that
 competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts.
 The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed
 as an Open draft).
