The campdraft events will be run in accordance with the Australian Bushman's Campdraft and Rodeo Association (ABCRA) rules and regulations. All **campdraft** event competitors must be current **ABCRA financial members**. There is day membership available for ABCRA.

All riders under the age of 18 **must wear helmets** while mounted on a horse in and around the Showgrounds. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and are to be securely fastened under the chin at all times.

Terms & Conditions

- Payment for nominations MUST be received by Tuesday the 16th of September 2025 Failure to pay will result in your nominations being forfeited.
- SCRATCHINGS: All scratchings received before Friday the 26th of September 2025, at 9am, will be refunded. Any scratchings submitted after this time and date will only be refunded at the committee's discretion.
- All horses are allowed no more than one first round start per event.
- Prize monies will be paid in accordance with ASCA rules and guidelines. No prize monies will be paid out on the weekend. Prize monies will be distributed through Campdraft Central, please ensure your current bank account details are correct and entered.
- The committee reserves the right to alter, change or delete any event listed on this program at any time.
- Competitors MUST adhere to the draw. Horses MUST be ridden in DRAW ORDER. Competitors may make a submission for a change to the draw PRIOR to the commencement of the event. This must be done at the **secretary's office**, or by contacting the secretary before the event commences. Under no circumstances will submissions to alter the draw be accepted after the event has commenced. The committee's decision is final.
- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge said complaint in writing with the secretary of the host committee within 1 hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$50 is forfeited.
- ALL stallions MUST be contained in accordance with NCCA rule 11.12.
- Neither the organising committee, Midcoast Council nor ASCA accept any liability for any damages, accident, loss or illness to horses, riders, beasts or any other person or property whatsoever.
