The Committee reserves the right to amend the program and/or any terms and conditions at its discretion. By entering this event, participants agree that photos and footage taken during the event may be used for promotional purposes by the event organisers, sponsors, and the Dalby Stock Horse Sale.

Proof of purchase and registration must be supplied upon request. Failure to provide documentation may result in disqualification.

All competitors must adhere to the Australian Stock Horse Society Code of Conduct. Any mistreatment of horses or unsportsmanlike behaviour may result in immediate disqualification and future exclusion.

In the event of event cancellation due to weather or unforeseen circumstances, refunds may be issued at the committee's discretion.

All entries are accepted at the rider's risk. The committee accepts no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to any person, horse, or property.

Campdrafts will be conducted in accordance with NCCA rules and guidelines.

Challenge events will be conducted in accordance with Australian Stock Horse Society (ASHS) competition rules and guidelines.

All Nomination Fees and Prizemoney listed is GST inclusive.

Horses and owners will only be eligible to receive prize money if all of the following conditions are fully met:

- All competitors must be current financial members of the Australian Stock Horse Society (ASHS). Accepted
 membership types include Full, Participant, or Temporary Membership. To arrange membership prior to the
 event, please contact ASHS on (02) 6545 2165. Temporary memberships will also be available at the
 secretary's box on the day and must be completed prior to competing in the draft.
- All horses must be registered with the Australian Stock Horse Society (ASHS) and be eligible for competition.
- Horses may compete a maximum of three times in the Aged and Gelding Campdrafts under the same ownership.
- Final placings will be determined based on aggregate scores.
- To be eligible for the Aged and Gelding Incentive Campdrafts, horses must be transferred into the purchaser's name at the point of sale and must remain registered under that name.
- For the purposes of this event, a horse's birth date is deemed to be 1st August.
- Any horse that has previously won an Incentive Campdraft is ineligible to compete in that same event again
 under the same ownership.
- When nominating for the Dalby ASH Sale Campdraft and Challenge events, the horse's full registered ASHS
 name and registration number must be used. Prize money will be paid to the person listed as the nominee in
 Campdraft Central, please ensure your account details are correct.
- A horse's status will be determined by the highest-status horse competing in the event and may be adjusted
 accordingly.
- A 'passed in' horse will be deemed eligible if it is purchased and the sale is lodged with the agent within 48 hours of the conclusion of the sale. Evidence must be provided if requested.
- Any competitor wishing to lodge a complaint relating to an event must do so in writing to the Secretary of the DDASHS Branch within one hour of the incident. Complaints must be submitted in accordance with Section 24 of the ASHS Handbook and must be accompanied by a \$50 fee. If the complaint is dismissed by the DDASHS Branch, the fee will be forfeited.
- All competitors under the age of 18 must wear an approved helmet at all times while mounted on the grounds. Failure to comply will result in the forfeiture of any scores awarded.
- If your power setup causes a fault to the electrical supply and an electrician is required to attend the grounds,
 you may be held responsible for the associated costs if it is determined that the fault resulted from negligence
 in your power arrangement.
- All competitors are required to complete the attached Horse Health Declaration form and submit it to the Secretary's Office upon arrival.
- All competitors must collect their wristband prior to the commencement of events. Competitors will not be permitted to enter the arena without a wristband.
- A full (100%) refund will be provided for scratchings are made prior to **12:00am on 18 November 2025**. After this time, the full nomination fee will be forfeited.
- If a scratching after this date is due to injury or illness, appropriate supporting evidence (e.g. veterinary or medical certificate) must be provided to the committee for consideration of a refund.
- For the purposes of eligibility under the Gelding Incentive, "immediate family" is defined as a husband, wife, mother, father, son, daughter, brother, or sister.

Horse Health Declaration

Following the recent confirmed cases of Hendra virus in Queensland, the Darling Downs Branch of the ASHS reminds all competitors of the importance of maintaining strong biosecurity and hygiene practices at our events.

Please ensure all animals are healthy prior to travelling.

If your horse becomes unwell during the event, report immediately to the Secretary's Box or the Ray White office. Any horse showing signs of illness may be isolated from the event area until assessed.

Avoid sharing equipment, and maintain a clean environment wherever possible.

All horses travelling to the event must be listed on your Horse Health Declaration, even if they are not competing or part of the sale.

Mandatory Requirement:

A completed Horse Health Declaration must be submitted to the Secretary's Box prior to the commencement of events. Once submitted, you will be issued with a wristband.


No wristband = No entry into the camp.


