Conditions:

- The committee reserves the right to alter the program or delete any event as necessary and to reject any entry at any time, particularly as cattle numbers are limited.
- Riders must be ASHS Members or purchase weekend membership (\$50) prior to commencement of Draft, horses do not need ASHS registered,
- Yards are available, \$5 per yard, first in best dressed, **MUST BE LEFT CLEAN.** fees will be collected at the draft.
- \$5 Footfall fee per horse for weekend, to be paid with entries
- \$10 Camping fee per truck/float, to be paid with entries
- \$15 Medical Levy applies per rider, to be paid with entries
- In accordance with ASHS Rules and Regulations 12.2 all competitors must wear a helmet when mounted.
- Juniors/ Juveniles (under 18) must not handle colts or stallions. All colts and stallions must be bitted.
- Cattle levy of \$17 is included in entry fees.
- Prizemoney to 4th, Ribbons to 6th. Prize Money 60% Payback. Prizemoney will be paid by direct deposit into your nominated bank account.
- Full refund for scratching until 4pm 1st December 2025. If a competitor withdraws after that date, the nomination fee will be retained by the Branch.
- Changes must be submitted in writing to the Events Secretary no later than 10am Saturday, changes for the Saturday Maiden must be submitted prior to 7pm Friday night.
- Junior and Juvenile - Junior 8 – under 13 and Juvenile 13 – under 17.
- Campdraft will be run Under COVID-19 Restrictions if required at time of event
