CONDITIONS

- Jandowae Campdraft Association is affiliated with CCA and is run in accordance with their General Information, Rules and Recommendations.
- Nominations via Campdraft Central opening 7am Monday 30th March 2026 for 24 hours
- Full payment for nominations as direct deposit as per Campdraft Central Invoice must be received by 5pm on Wednesday 8th April 2026, unpaid nominations will be scratched
- Horse health declaration to be handed in on arrival to showgrounds
- All prizemoney exclude GST & will be paid as per CCA rule 24 by direct deposit following the event
- All changes are to be made before the commencement of the draft at the secretary's office, no changes accepted after the draft has started
- No junior competitors to be nominated in the open age campdrafts
- Any horse or rider changes throughout the weekend are asked to pay a fee of \$5 that will be donated to a charity nominated by the committee.
- Nominations are not refundable when cancellations are made with in the seven (7) days of the commencement of the draft, except under extenuating circumstances at the discretion of the committee, a refund applied and a \$20 cattle levy retained by the committee
- All riders under 18 years of age MUST wear approved helmets while riding on the grounds (refer to rule 19 of CCA General Rules & Guidelines- Children under 8 years of age are not allowed in the arena whilst an event is in progress- Exception to rule is mini's competing in event.
- All stallions to be contained on the grounds as per CCA rule 11.12. Under no circumstances are children under the age of 17 permitted to ride/handle stallions within the perimeter of the grounds
- Jandowae Campdraft Association reserves the right to alter or amend the program in any way whatsoever & reserves the right to refuse entries without reason
- All competitors compete at their own risk
- In all cases the Judge's decision will be final
- Any competitors who, in the opinion of the Executive Committee and/or Chief Steward, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and participating in any further events on the program & no refund of nomination will be offered
- The Jandowae Campdraft Association does not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- **Dogs must be kept on leash or secured at all times. Not allowed near camp or canteen area.**
- Riding/driving on the racetrack is strictly prohibited- \$1000 fine be paid to committee for anyone in breach
- Complaints: Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the committee within 1 hour of the incident taking place and a fee of \$50 must be lodged, if the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$50 is forfeited.
- The committee reserves the right to utilize images captured throughout the weekend for advertising, promotional or grant application purposes, should you not wish for any images of yourself or your family to be utilized please contact the secretary.

Declaration by owner or person in charge of horse/s attending

I, declare that the horse/s named above has/have been in good health, eating normally and not shown signs of illness during the last three (3) days leading up to this event. I give my authorisation for the Event Organising Committee/Manager/Event Biosecurity Officer hereinafter referred to as Event Organisers, to call for veterinary inspection of the horse/s named above and in my care should they be showing signs of illness at any time during the course of the event. I agree to pay any veterinary fees incurred for the above mentioned horses as a result of this veterinary examination.

- I AGREE TO ENSURE THAT:
1. If required, before movement, all horses will be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry and their hooves will be picked clean of all solid material and washed with shampoo.
 2. All vehicles and equipment accompanying the horse/s will be cleaned to removal all solid material that could contain disease agents and then disinfected.
 3. The information contained in this DECLARATION is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
 4. I agree to abide by all conditions that may be imposed at any time by the Event Organisers.
 5. I acknowledge that in failure to comply, I may be directed to leave and my nominations will be forfeited.
 6. I acknowledge that decontamination and disinfection procedures may be required of me if instructed by the Event Organisers.
 7. I acknowledge that there is a possibility that horses might become infected with disease agents as a result of any movements and if necessary horses and premises will be quarantined in accordance with any Legislation covering such occurrences including policies and procedures in effect at that time.
 8. I agree and acknowledge that the Event Organisers, its State and/or National Affiliated bodies and their members are not in any way liable for any cost, expense, loss, damage, claim, action, proceeding or other liability incurred by or made against me as a result of any movement of horses to the Event.
