Patterns: Dry & Wet Work - patterns to be release early December

Wet Work - Separate to your campdraft run

Attire: Long Sleeve Button Down Shirt, Tie or Neck Scarf for women, jeans or moleskins, riding boots.

Hats: Australian style hat to be worn whilst competing - Encouragement & U18 MUST wear helmets at all times.

Bits: Free rolling loose ring snaffle with smooth mouth piece to be used in all phases - no twisted wires or sharp edges allowed.
A bit check will be completed.

Reins: Personal choice.

Saddle: Australian type stock saddle with knee pads, NO horn. No penalty for back girth.

NOT ALLOWED: Tie Downs or Martingales of any description, nosebands, or any other artifical device are not to be used.

All riders **MUST** be registered with CCA to compete, you MUST complete your membership with your nominations.

All competitors ride at own risk.
