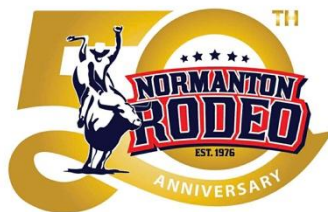
- Campdraft events are conducted by Normanton Rodeo Association Inc. and run in conjunction with CCA rules, guidelines and recommendations.

- All riders under the age of 18 years must wear a helmet at all times whilst riding a horse.
- All Round Cowboy & Cowgirl points are allocated for certain events as 1st = 4, 2nd = 3, 3rd = 2, 4th = 1 EXCEPT in the Open Team Roping where they are allocated as 1st = 2, 2nd = 1.5, 3rd = 1, 4th = 0.5. For a full list of eligible events please see our website www.nqrodeohub.com.au
- All ties for first place in rodeo events will be decided by a ride off.

CAMPDRAFT

- Campdraft events are conducted by Normanton Rodeo Association Inc. and run in conjunction with CCA rules, guidelines and recommendations.
- **Entry method:** Online through Campdraft Central – www.campdraftcentral.com.au
- **Event membership:** All competitors **MUST add the \$10 CCA Event fee when nominating**
- **Horse status:** Any event advertised as a campdraft, either in written or verbal form of advertising, shall change the status of a horse whether the event is affiliated with a recognised Campdraft Association or not.
- **Maiden Draft:** The Maiden A Draft will take place solely on Thursday afternoon. If you are nominating in the Maiden, please make it your plan to be in Normanton by 1pm on Thursday.
- **Teams Draft:** Teams of 3 are to draft one head of stock around a complete campdraft course. Teams are to consist of 3 people. All competitors must be over 17 years, and work for the same station, contracting crew or workplace. Competitors are only allowed to compete as part of one team. There is no limit to the number of teams per workplace.
- **Restricted Open Draft:** Open horses only. Nominations are restricted to one horse per rider. This event is limited to 30 competitors.
- **First Round Runs:** Campdraft nominations are limited to 10 first round runs (excluding Team Penning, Restricted Open and Teams Draft).
- **Scratchings:** Scratchings are to be made 7 days before the start of an event. Scratchings made within the 7-day period before the event may forfeit their entry fees at the committee's discretion. All approved nominations must be paid in full by 6pm Sunday 24th May. The committee has the right to waitlist any unpaid competitors and offer those positions to existing waitlisted competitors, if not paid by the advertised date.
- **Change of horse:** If there is a change of horse over the weekend, the competitor must inform the Secretary's Office so that the Penciller of the event can be notified.
- **Stallions:** All stallions are to be collared and yarded. Under no circumstances are members under the age of 17 years permitted to ride/ handle stallions within the perimeter of the grounds.
- **Complaints:** Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint must do so **in writing** with the Secretary within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 will be forfeited.
- All dogs must be always kept on a leash and/or be kept securely tied up whilst on the grounds.
- Judge's decision in all cases will be FINAL.
- All prize money is inclusive of GST where applicable.
- **All riders under the age of 18 MUST wear a helmet while riding.**

RODEO

- NQRA Affiliated
- **Entry method:** Online through www.ngrodeohub.com.au
- **Event Membership** – All competitors must pay a membership fee (Senior \$30, Junior \$10) when nominating. **ALL COMPETITORS MUST ATTEND THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE TO SIGN MEMBERSHIP & WAIVER FORMS PRIOR TO COMPETING.**
- **Junior Competitors (U18)** must wear a helmet while mounted in all timed events. Junior roughstock competitors must wear a vest and helmet.
- **All Round Cowboy and Cowgirl:**
 - Eligible events: Open Bull Ride, Open Bronc Ride, Open Team Roping, Calf Roping, Steer Wrestling, Novice Bronc Ride, Novice Bull Ride, Ladies Barrel Race, Steer Undecorating, Women's Ranch Bronc Ride and Ladies Breakaway Roping
 - Points are allocated as 1st = 4 points, 2nd = 3 points, 3rd = 2 points and 4th = 1 point **EXCEPT** in the Open Team Roping, where points are allocated as 1st = 2 points, 2nd = 1.5 points, 3rd = 1 point and 4th = .5 points (1/2 points)
- **Ladies Barrel Race** is run over two rounds (Friday and Saturday) and a final, with all 1D qualifiers advancing to the final on Sunday afternoon. Each horse and rider combination will run in both rounds. Round Money is paid out for 1st Division in both rounds. The average for 2nd and 3rd Division will be paid at the completion of round two. The 1st Division average will be paid upon the completion of the final.
- **Junior Barrel Race** is run over one round on Sunday. Nominations are restricted to one horse per rider. Open barrel horses cannot be ridden in this event. A rider nominated in the Juvenile Barrel Race cannot be entered in the Ladies Barrel Race.
- **Calf Ride** – **STRICTLY UNHELD** Calves cannot be held as per animal welfare regulations. No spurs are to be worn. All competitors must wear a vest and helmet.
- **Bullock Ride** – A rider nominated in an Open Roughstock Event cannot nominate in the Bullock Ride.
- **Open Bull Ride** - A rider nominated in the Open Bull Ride cannot nominate in the Bullock Ride, Novice Bull Ride or Station Buckjump. All competitors must wear a vest.
- **Open Saddle Bronc** - A rider nominated in the Open Saddle Bronc cannot nominate in Novice Saddle Bronc, Station Buckjump or Bullock Ride.
- All ties for first place will be decided by a ride off.

GYMKHANA

- Gymkhana events will be run as per the Pony Club Australia guidelines.
- All competitors must complete a membership form and waiver before competing.
- Any adults that enter the arena to assist young competitors must also complete a membership form and waiver.
- ALL competitors must wear a helmet while mounted, including open age competitors. Helmets must meet the required Australian Standards and be fastened securely.
