Conditions

- **All horses to remain on the inside of the racetrack. A Minimum \$1000 fine for anyone found damaging the golf greens (inside or outside of grounds) – KEEP CLEAR AT ALL TIMES**
- All competitors ride at their own risk and must be ready to compete when called
- No Juniors & Juveniles in any open aged drafts
- The Kumbia and District Charity Campdraft Association Inc. Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program in any way
- **PROGRAM:** is CCA affiliated & run in accordance with the – General Information Rules and Recommendations.
- **SCRATCHINGS:** A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 120 hours (5 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 120 hours (5 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee
- **CHANGES:** All required horse or rider changes after the draws are finalised must be completed 1 hour prior to the commencement of the applicable draft. Once the Campdraft weekend has started, a **\$5 change fee** will be incurred for any changes which will be donated to “National Breast Cancer Foundation” (immediate payment or no changes will be done).
- **HELMETS:** Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all CCA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- **STALLIONS:** All stallions are to be contained in accordance with the CCA General Information Rules and Recommendations.
- **COMPLAINTS:** Judges decision is final.
