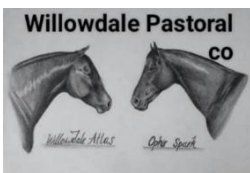

- The Committee reserves the right to alter the program or cancel any event at any time and their decision will be final.
- Judges' decision in all cases will be FINAL.
- All riders Under 18yrs MUST wear approved helmets while riding on the grounds (refer to Rule 19 of CCA General Rules and Guidelines).
- Helmets must comply with current safety standards and be securely fastened under the chin at all times. All riders compete at their own risk.
- Any competitors who, in the opinion of the Executive Committee and/or Chief Steward, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and also from participating in any further events on the program. No refund of nominations will be offered.
- Rider restrictions – **8 run 1st round limit per competitor.**
- Prize monies paid as per CCA General Rules & Guidelines 24.

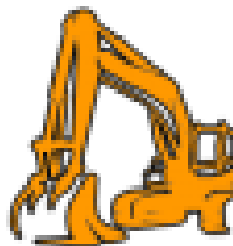
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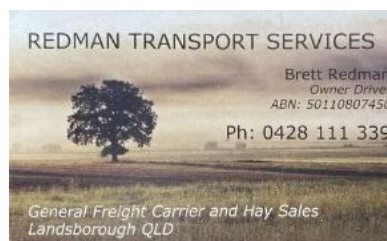

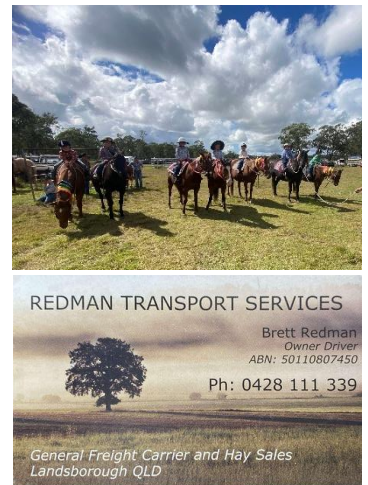
