OTHER CONDITIONS/ INFORMATION

1. Nominations will be VIA Campdraft Central and will open on Monday 17th August at 7am For 24hrs. Nominations must be lodged online at www.campdraftcentral.com.au
2. Payment will be required in full by Wednesday 26th August 4pm to secure your place.
3. Program is CCA affiliated & run in accordance with the CCA Rules & Guidelines, CCA Event of \$10inc, ALL competitors must add this event type when nominating via Campdraft Central
4. All competitors ride at their own risk and must sign a waiver and hand in a Horse Health Declaration to compete. PIC **QBWC0827**
5. Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all CCA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
6. Nominating for the draft deems that competitors have read and understood the conditions.
7. A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor with draws more than 7 days prior to 8 am on the first morning of the program.

If a competitor withdraws less than 7 days prior to 8 am on the first morning of the program, then the entire nomination fee may be retained at the discretion of the Committee. If the Committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the Committee. If the event is cancelled, all nominations will be refunded in full

8. Teebar Showgrounds are in a tick area. Competitors must arrange their own permits/spraying.

9. The Committee reserves the right to make changes to this Interim Programme, and/or restrict entry numbers in all Drafts, if required.
