Dingo Campdraft - Rules and Stipulations

- Prize Money: Paid as per ACA rule R.6 and R.9; used for percentages.
- Scratchings: 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 7 days prior to 6AM on Friday the 8th of May. If the competitor withdraws less than 7 days before this time, the entire nomination may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply then a refund may be granted; each case is at the discretion of the committee.
- Helmets: Riders under the age of 18 must wear a helmet whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events.
- Medical Services: Provided by the Queensland Ambulance Service.
- Complaints: Any competitors wishing to lodge a complaint must do so in writing to the secretary within one hour of the incidence taking place. A \$100 fee must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$100 is forfeited.
- Stallions: All stallions must be contained as per NCCA rule; Stallions must not be ridden by anyone under 17 years of age.
- Run Restrictions: 8 first round runs per competitor (Excluding Restricted Open)
- Juvenile (13 & under 17) Junior (8 & Under 13) Mini (Under 8)
- Program Altering: The committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time.
- ACA Rules: All riders compete at their own risk and must adhere to ACA rules; Judges decision is Final.
- ACA: ACA requires all competitors to ensure all details mirror those of their ACA member & horse profiles across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.
- Horse Status: The status of the horse winning a Campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exemption of Junior, Juveniles, and Ladies.
- Limited Camping Area and Power: Generators will NOT be supplied; Please be respectful of the amount of area you occupy.
- Services: Canteen and Bar will be operating; Live entertainment on Friday and Saturday night.
- Presentations: Will be held immediately after each event.
- Futurity Horses: Must be 5 years and under and not have started in an open age draft.
- Stock Levy: A stock levy of \$25 is included in all nominations.
- "All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program".
