General Rules

All competitors ride at their own risk. Medical Provider is QLD Ambulance.

Nebo Campdraft & Challenge is CCA Affiliated & run-in accordance with the General Information, Rules & Recommendations

Plus, the following rules apply:

The Classic Hore Challenge is open to all horses 4 years of age & under, determined by date of birth.

The Futurity Draft is open to all horses aged 5 years & under - aged from 1st August each year. (2021 year drop upwards) &:

(a) NOT TO BE STARTED IN ANY OPEN AGED DRAFT’S.

(b) A horse’s birthdate will be determined by the papers registration and must be uploaded onto Campdraft Central.

(c) Unregistered horses must be accompanied by a vet certificate stating their age at owner’s expense.

SCRATCHINGS: 100% refund on nomination fee will be given to competitors who withdraw 168 hrs (7 days) prior to 8am of the first morning of the program, if a competitor withdraws less than 168 hrs (7 days) then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee. Scratching’s will incur a \$20 stock levy.

All Prize monies paid as per CCA General Rules & Guidelines, Section 24.

Conditions of Entry:

The Committee reserves the right to alter/amend the program at any time!

All horses are to be run as drawn order in draft. NO changes to the draws will be made after 4pm prior to the start of each day.

PLEASE LOG ONTO CAMPDRAFT CENTRAL AND SORT THE ORDER YOU WISH YOUR HORSES TO COMPETE!!

Judges’ decision in all cases will be FINAL. All riders Under 18yrs MUST wear approved helmets while riding on the grounds (refer to Rule 19 of CCA General Rules and Guidelines). Under no circumstances are members under the age of 17yrs permitted to ride/handle stallions within the perimeter of the grounds. If required, Horse Health Declarations must accompany horses when travelling. Declaration must be completed and presented to the Secretaries office upon arrival.

Any competitors who, in the opinion of the Executive Committee and/or Judge, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and also from participating in any further events on the program. No refund of nominations will be offered

All dogs must be always kept on a leash and/or be kept securely tied up whilst on the grounds & not allowed near the canteen.

Challenge Rules

Long sleeve shirt with scarf/tie and hat/helmet. Australian saddle (no horn), loose ring snaffle bit with one join, no twisted wire bits, no nosebands or tie-downs allowed.

Rookie Rider definition: Not to have placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in ANY Challenge, (excluding a Rookie or Encouragement Challenge), or won a Rookie Challenge. (This will apply whether the Challenge was affiliated with the ASCA or not).

Classic & Open challenges consist of 2 sections judged out of 100 points. Top ten proceed to final – no clean slate.

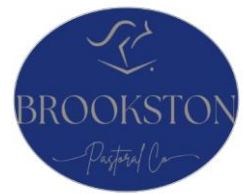
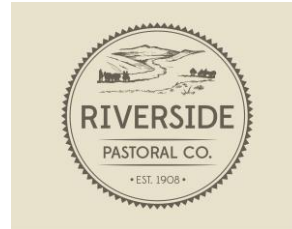
Dry work: Patterns following on this Program. Zero score for a manoeuvre will be given at the judge’s discretion for: horse out of control, rider falling, major deviation from pattern, omitting a manoeuvre.

Cattle work: Full yard of cattle except for under 13 years. Losing the beast back to the mob twice will result in no score for cut out.

The beast will be removed and the run will continue outside. 1 peg for first and second and one gate peg to allow for either left or right hand course. If a peg is missed ride on – one attempt at each peg. To be scored 25 points for cut out and 25 points for each circle outside. Outside runs will be scored until disqualified or run is completed (must complete 3 circles - ride to whip).

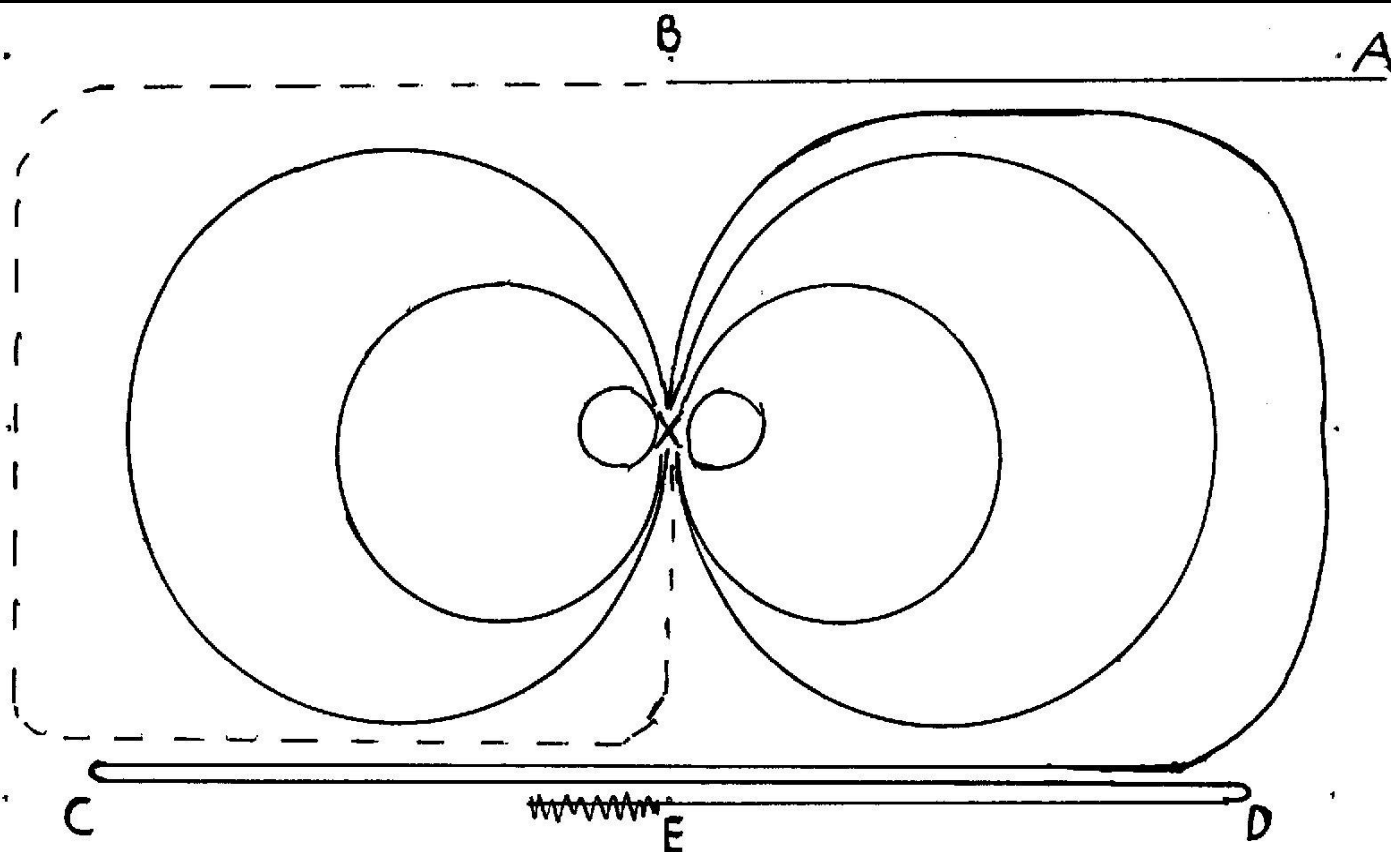

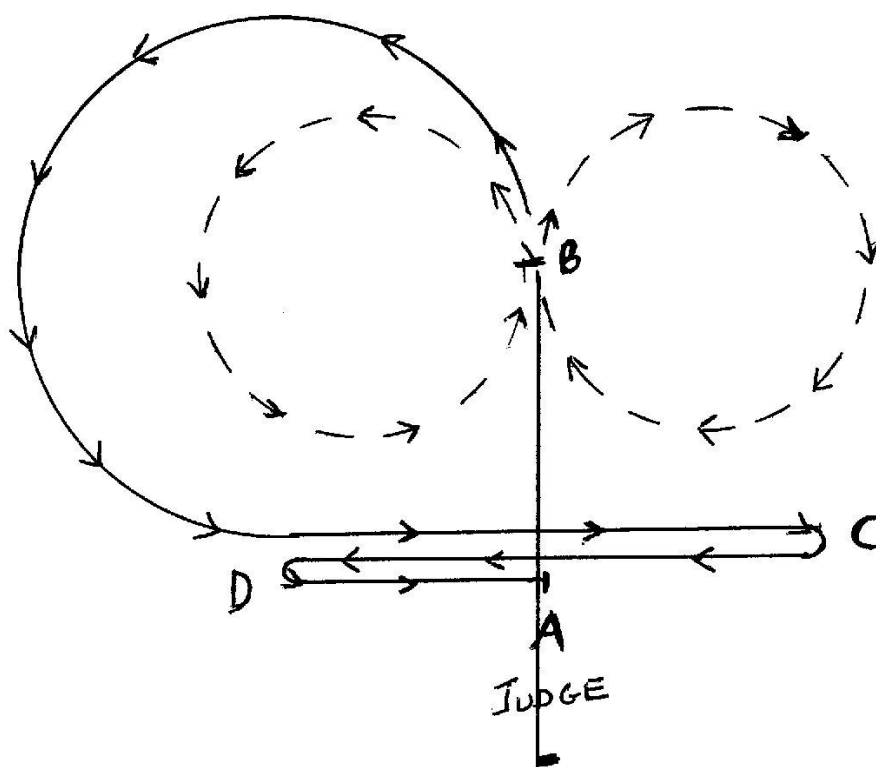


Classic Challenge Dry Work Pattern

Open Challenge Dry Work Pattern

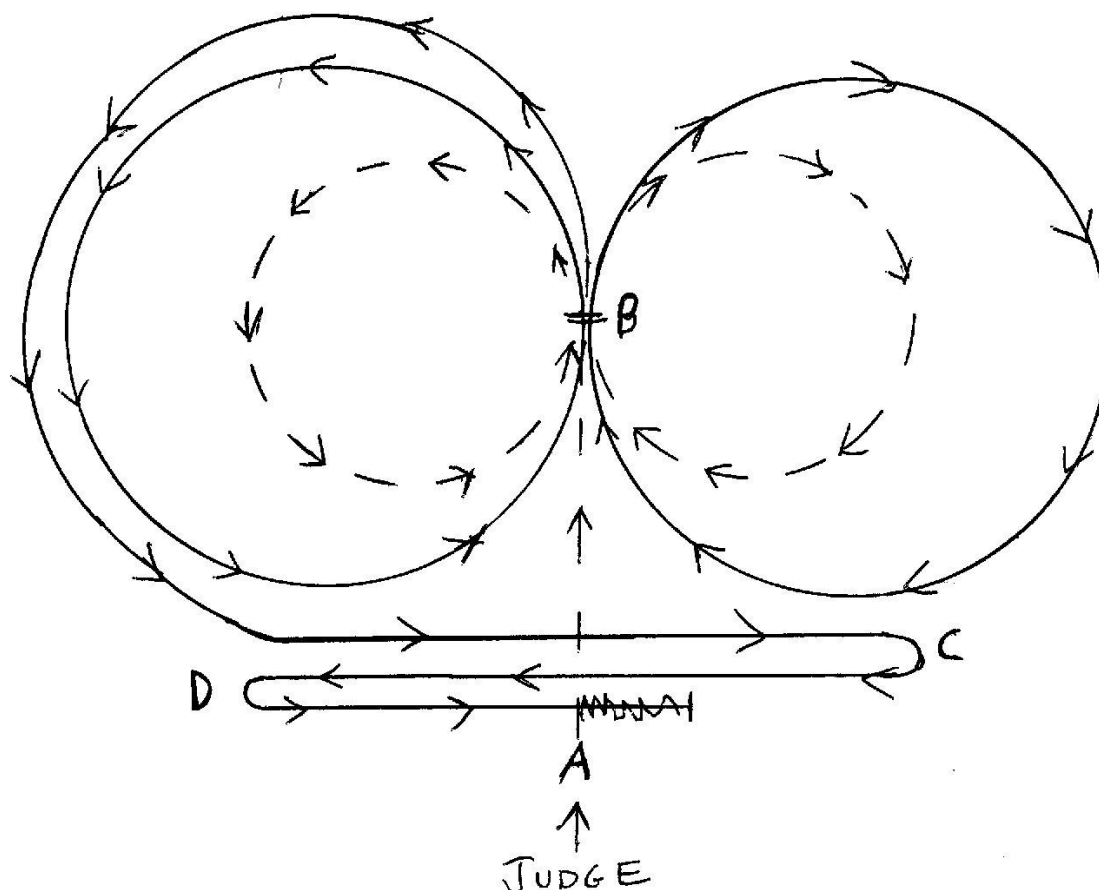

| 1. Enter arena at A, walk cracking whip to B | 10 |
| 2. At B, collected working trot around arena to X | 10 |
| 3. At X, 2 spins left, 2 spins right. Settle | 10 |
| 4. Fast canter large circle to the right, slow canter small circle to the right | 10 |
| 5. At X flying change | 10 |
| 6. Slow canter small circle left, fast canter large circle to the left | 10 |
| 7. At X flying change | 10 |
| 8. Don't close circle, canter around arena to C, stop, roll back to the left | 10 |
| 9. Canter down to D, stop, roll back to the right | 10 |
| 10. Canter past E, stop, back up at least 8 paces to E. | |
| Acknowledge judge & leave arena on a loose rein at the walk. | 10 |

MINI & JUNIOR DRY WORK PATTERN

| 1. Wave to judge & walk into arena at A and walk out to B | 10 |
| 2. At B trot a circle to the left | 15 |
| 3. At B trot a circle to the right | 15 |
| 4. At B canter a larger circle to the left then around to C | 15 |
| 5. At C stop and roll back to the right | 10 |
| 6. Canter across to D, stop and roll back to the left | 10 |
| 7. Canter to A and stop | 10 |
| 8. Turn towards judge, acknowledge and walk out | 5 |
| 9. Overall presentation | 10 |



JUVENILE DRY WORK PATTERN

| 1. Wave to judge & walk into arena at A and walk out to B | 5 |
| 2. At B trot a circle to the left | 10 |
| 3. At B trot a circle to the right | 10 |
| 4. At B canter a larger circle to the left, at B simple change | 15 |
| 5. Canter a larger circle to the right, at B simple change | 15 |
| 6. Fast canter a larger circle left then canter round to C | 10 |
| 7. At C stop and roll back to the right | 10 |
| 8. Canter across to D, stop and roll back to the left | 10 |
| 9. Canter just past A, stop and back up 4 paces | 10 |
| 10. Turn to judge, acknowledge and walk out on a loose rein | 5 |
