Challenges & Campdraft events are open to any breed, registered or unregistered.

To be eligible for ASHS High Point Awards, you must be an ASHS member or temporary member & you must compete in the Hacks & Leds. Registrations numbers must be included with nominations.

Ringer Riders must be over 17yrs of age to nominate. Ringer Riders cannot have won an Open/Futurity/Ringers Challenge. They may compete in the Open and Futurity Challenge.

Competitors are limited to 6 first round Campdraft runs excluding the Futurity draft.

Futurity Draft - Restricted to horses aged five (5) years and under, with the horse's age determined as of August 1st each year. Proof of age documents must be uploaded to Campdraft Central when nominating. Futurity horses may compete in the Novice Campdraft

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- 1. AFFILIATION:** Hacks & Leds are ASHS Affiliated & Challenges & Campdrafts are CCA Affiliated. All events are run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines'.
- 2. MEMBERSHIP:** Competitors must be financial ASHS members or Day Members to be eligible for High Point ASHS awards. Membership numbers and horse registration numbers must be included when nominating. \$50 for adult membership and \$20 for youth membership (under 18).
- 3. NOMINATIONS:** All nominations will include a \$10 stock levy
- 4. HELMETS:** Competitors under 18 years of age must wear an equestrian helmet approved by the current Australian Standards Association or International equivalent, which must be securely fastened under the chin, when mounted anywhere within the perimeter of the grounds, including all public areas.
- 5. PRIZE MONEY:** All prize money will be paid as per CCA general rules and guidelines no. 24.
- 6. SCRATCHING:** A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168hrs (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
- 7. JUVENILE/JUNIOR:** Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and Juniors (8 years to under 13 years).
- 8. COMPLAINTS:** "Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited".
- 9. STALLIONS:** Confinement requirement - refer to CCA Rule 11.12.
- 10. PROGRAM:** The committee has the right to alter the program at their discretion
