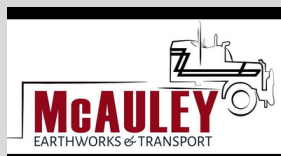

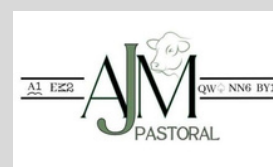

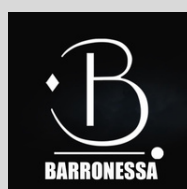

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- **AFFILIATION:** Events are CCA Affiliated and run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines'
- All horses are to be run as drawn order in draft. NO changes to the draws will be made after the start of each event.
- All prize monies paid as per CCA General Rules and Guidelines Section 24.
- Judges' decision in all cases will be FINAL.
- All riders under 18yrs MUST wear approved helmets while riding on the grounds (refer to Rule 19 of CCA General Rules and Guidelines).
- Under no circumstances are members under the age of 17yrs permitted to ride/handle stallions within the perimeter of the grounds.
- Horse Health Declarations must be completed and presented to the Secretaries office upon arrival.
- Any competitors who, in the opinion of the Executive Committee and/or Chief Steward, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and also from participating in any further events on the program. No refund of nominations will be offered.
- The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
- All **stallions** are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.2 of the CCA Rules.
- Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at any affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the Host Committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$50 is forfeited.
