Conditions of Entry

All horses are to be run in the drawn order in the draft. No changes to the draw will be made after 60 minutes prior to the start of each draft.

Kilcoy Campdraft Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program.

All drafts will be run under current CCA rules. Program is CCA Affiliated and run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules and Guidelines'.

Any competitor who, in the opinion of the Chief Steward, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and also from participating in any further events on the program. No refund of nominations will be offered.

The committee reserves the right to refuse entries without reason.

Riders are limited to 6 first round runs (excluding M4M, Ladies and Restricted Open).

Horses to be nominated in the order in which they are to be ridden.

A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8am on the first morning of the program, the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee.

Campdraft competitors must hold themselves ready to compete at the advertised starting time on the day of the draft. Three calls will be made for competitors. If the competitor fails to appear, nomination fees paid shall be forfeited to Kilcoy Campdraft Committee.

Nomination fees refunded only if competitors or horses are injured and if approved by the Chief Steward. There will be a stock levy of \$30 on each scratching.

All nominations to be submitted through Campdraft Central. No nominations accepted over the phone or by email.

The Kilcoy Campdraft Committee will not be responsible for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horse, rider, spectator, or any other person or property whatsoever. Competitors ride at their own risk.

Judge's decision in all cases will be final.

Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint must lodge it in writing within one (1) hour of the incident occurring. A fee of \$50 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee, the \$50 is forfeited.

All riders under 18 years must wear approved skull caps when riding on the grounds, regardless of whether they are competing or not. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times (refer to Rule 19 of CCA General Rules and Guidelines).

Under no circumstances are riders under the age of 17 permitted to ride/handle stallions within the perimeter of the grounds. Stallion Containment Requirements as per Rule 11.12 of CCA General Rules and Guidelines.

Highest Scoring Lady Rider trophy – lady rider competitor must be 17 years and over.

Highest Scoring Local Rider prize – competitor must reside in postcode 4515.

Minimum age for a rider at a CCA affiliated event is 5 years.

NO glass/alcohol permitted to be brought onto the grounds.

NO fires permitted on the grounds; this includes contained fires. This is a council condition of use of the grounds.

All dogs must be always kept on a leash and/or securely tied up whilst on the grounds.

First Aid Officers will be on the grounds all weekend. Honorary stock inspectors on grounds.

A Horse Health Declaration must accompany horses when travelling. The declaration must be completed and presented to the Secretary's office on arrival – Kilcoy Campdraft, 26 Showgrounds Road, Woolmar QLD 4515, PIC #QEK0434.
