1. **Restrictions:**
 - **Open events –**
 - **Eight first round runs** per competitor, excluding the Ladies run.
 - **Three runs maximum per competitor** in the open age events - Maiden, Novice and Open.
 - **Juveniles – Two runs per competitor in Juvenile draft.** Can nominate in the Maiden and Novice drafts.
 - **Juniors – One run per competitor,** not eligible to nominate in any open events.
2. **Nominations:** via campdraftcentral.com.au - **Open Tuesday 1st September at 6pm for 24 Hours.** Nominations will not be processed without payment which must be received by **Tuesday 8th September.** Unpaid nominations will be cancelled after this date. Please nominate in horse order.
3. **Competitors: All competitors must add \$10 CCA Event Fee.**
4. **All payments MUST reference the Campdraft Central invoice number.**
5. **Changes:** to the draw will only be accepted up to 12 hours prior to the start of the draft, incurring a \$5 fee (donated to charity). No changes will be accepted after this time - other than scratching.
6. **Program:** is CCA Affiliated and run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines'. All events to be conducted under the rule of the CCA, Qld Chamber of Agriculture Societies, and the Bell Show Society where each applies.
7. **Prize Money:** payouts as per CCA General Rules 24.
8. **Bell Committee:** reserves the right to refuse entries without any reason, alter or amend the program in any way whatsoever and if required close nominations earlier, due to possible shortage of cattle.
9. **Competitors:** compete at their own risk and acknowledge that it is a condition of acceptance of their nomination that neither the Bell Show Society Inc, nor the Western Downs Regional Council will be responsible for any injury, loss, or damage.
10. **Helmets:** Anyone under the age of 18 years must always wear a helmet whilst riding a horse.
11. **Scratching's:** A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 7 days prior to 8am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 7 days prior to 8am on the first morning of the program, then the entire nomination fee will be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
12. **Status of a Horse or Rider:** As per CCA General Information Rules and Recommendations – Campdraft Rules Section 9.
13. **Stallions:** Under no circumstances are members under the age of 17 years permitted to ride/handle stallions within the perimeters of the ground.
14. **Junior Events:** Ages 8 years to under 13 years. Junior Campdraft are to be judged the same as Juvenile Campdraft, however with one beast in the yard and leniency shown at the judge's discretion. Juniors to compete on any status horse, except stallions.
15. **Juvenile Events:** Ages 13 to under 17 years. Juveniles to compete on any status horse, except stallions.
16. **Complaints:** Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at the Bell Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the Bell Show Society Campdraft Committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 (cash only) must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited.
17. **Exotic Animal Disease:** In the case of any outbreak occurring prior to or during the Campdraft, all equine animals must remain at the Bell Showgrounds and abide by the DEEDI rulings and guidelines at that time. All costs incurred are to bourn by the competitor and in no way is the Bell Show Society Inc. or the Bell Campdraft Committee liable for the expenses in the case of a lock-down.
18. **Highest scoring Local Rider must live at postcode 4408 or be on the Bell Campdraft Association Inc committee.**
