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CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This event is affiliated with the Campdraft Central Association Inc. (CCA) and will be conducted in accordance with the current CCA General Rules and Recommendations, unless otherwise stated in these Conditions of Entry.
2. KellCo Rural Agencies & Committee accepts no responsibility or liability for any accident, injury, illness, loss or damage suffered by any competitor, horse, spectator or other person, or for any loss or damage to property whilst attending the event.
3. Horses must be nominated in the order they are intended to be ridden.
4. The Judge's decision is final.
5. All campdraft events must be won outright unless otherwise determined by the Committee.
6. The Committee reserves the right to alter, amend, cancel or combine any event or part of the program where necessary.
7. The Committee's decision on all matters relating to the conduct of the event, eligibility, nominations and competition is final and binding.
8. No horse or rider substitutions will be permitted within 60 minutes of the commencement of the relevant draft. For the first draft of each day, all substitutions must be completed by 5:30pm on the preceding day, unless otherwise approved by the Committee due to exceptional circumstances.
9. Any competitor who changes a nominated horse or rider from the published draw after the commencement of that event may be disqualified unless prior approval has been granted by the Committee due to extenuating circumstances.
10. In accordance with CCA Rule 19, all competitors under the age of 18 years must wear an approved protective helmet whenever mounted within the event grounds.
11. Any competitor who, in the opinion of the Committee or appointed officials, deliberately mistreats or abuses livestock may be disqualified from the event and prohibited from competing in any further events. No nomination refund will be payable.
12. Competitors under 17 years of age are not permitted to ride or handle stallions anywhere within the event grounds.
13. All stallions must be securely contained at all times whilst on the grounds.
14. Dogs are welcome but must remain on a leash or be securely restrained at all times.
15. The Committee reserves the right to refuse or reject any nomination at its absolute discretion.
16. Nomination Refunds:
 - A full refund of nomination fees will be provided where a competitor withdraws prior to the closing of draws.
 - Once draw preparation has commenced, nomination fees may be retained by the Committee.
 - Refund requests submitted after the draws have commenced may be considered only in exceptional circumstances and remain at the Committee's discretion.
 - By submitting a nomination, competitors acknowledge they have read, understood and agree to abide by these Conditions of Entry, together with the current CCA Rules and any directions issued by the Committee during the event.
