EVENT CONDITIONS

- Gravesend Rodeo & Campdraft Association is affiliated with CCA and is run in accordance with their General Information, Rules and Recommendations.
- **All competitors MUST add the \$10 CCA Event fee when nominating**
- 8 run limit per competitor.
- Committee not registered for GST.
- All prize money paid as per CCA General Rules & Guidelines Section 24.
- All events paid out 1st to 5th.
- All horses are to be run as drawn order in draft. NO changes to be made to the draw.
- Failure to notify of scratchings within 72 hours of the event will forfeit entire entry fee.
- Horses are limited to two first round runs with the exception of the Junior, Juvenile & Ladies Campdraft events.
- The committee reserves the right to refuse any nomination for any event.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time.
- Judges' decision in all cases will be final.
- All riders Under 18 years MUST wear approved helmets while riding on the grounds (refer to Rule 19 of CCA)
- All Stallions to be contained on grounds as per CCA rule 11.12. Under no circumstances are members under the age of 17 years permitted to ride / handle stallions within the perimeter of the grounds.
- Any competitor who, in the opinion of the Executive Committee and/or Chief Steward, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and from participating in any further events on the program. No refund of nominations will be offered.
- All dogs must be kept on a leash and/or be kept securely tied up whilst on the grounds.
- No powered camping available.
- No glass to be brought onto the ground.
- Entry fee includes: \$20.00 stock levy & \$3.00 first aid levy.
