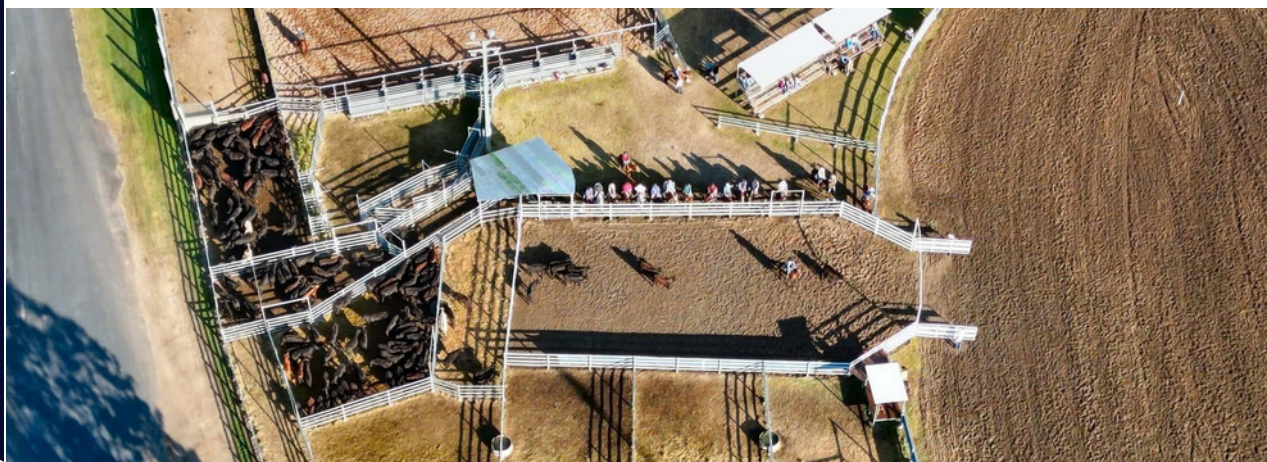

General Information

- JUVENILE Competitors are not permitted to ride in open age events.
- Competitors to state name of horse and preferred order when nominating.
- The committee reserves the right to alter (or delete) the program as it sees fit and as circumstances dictate.
- Prizemoney paid out in accordance with Rule B.5 of ACA Rules.
- HELMETS: Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
- SCRATCHING: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
- COMPLAINTS: "Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited".
- STALLIONS: All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules.
