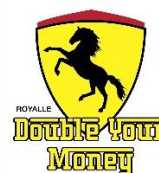

2. Nominations to be paid in full by 5pm – 14th August 2026
3. Nebo Showgrounds PIC: QGNB0187
4. AFFILIATION: All events are ACA Affiliated
5. Medical Service Provider: QAS services
6. HELMETS: Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australia and New Zealand and safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.
7. SCRATCHING: A 100% refund of nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8AM on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8 AM of the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee (which includes a \$20 stock levy) may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
8. COMPLAINTS: Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated Campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the secretary of the host committee within one hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be paid when the complaint is lodged. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited.
9. HORSE'S STATUS: The status of a horse winning a Campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes, except for Junior's, Juveniles, Ladies, Men's, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement drafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (e.g., if one open horse competes then it is classed as an open draft).
10. NOMINATIONS: Your ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nominations will not be processed. Weekend Membership is available - contact ACA office.
11. Mini/JUNIOR/JUVENILE: Mini (Under 8s No Led Riders) Junior (8 years and under 13 years) and juvenile (13 years and under 17 years) Must not ride stallions on the grounds at any time.
12. Competitors ride at their own risk and the committee will not be held responsible for horse and competitor.
13. Committee reserves the right to alter, amend, or cancel any event or include other events if deemed advisable, without notice.
14. Prize money will be paid as per ACA guidelines (R8, R9)
15. Program is ACA Affiliated & run in accordance with the 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines
16. ACA requires all competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.
17. Casual/ Weekend Membership Available. Contact ACA prior to nominating to arrange your Campdraft One Casual Profile.
18. Stock Levy – All nominations will incur a \$25 stock levy included in nominations.

Casual Memberships & Event Fees



\$25 - Casual ACA Membership Fee. This is an annual membership type that allows members to nominate for events where casual memberships are accepted. Casual Membership can not be upgraded to another membership throughout the year.

How do I become a Casual Member if I don't have a Campdraft One profile?

1. To become a Casual Member of ACA if you do not yet have a Campdraft One account, visit the ACA website and find the New Member Application Form under the Contact Us tab or call the ACA Office during office hours to create a Campdraft One profile. PH: (07) 4622 3110.
2. Pay for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.

How do I become a Casual Member if I already have a Campdraft One profile?

1. Sign into your Campdraft One profile.
2. Go to 'My Profile'. Here you will see a blue banner directing you to pay your membership.

3. Select who you wish to pay the membership for, then select membership type, 'Casual Membership', select 'Check Out' and proceed to payment for your \$25 (GST inc.) Casual Membership. This makes you a financial member of ACA until the 31st December.

\$100 - Event Membership Fee: payable to the Committee once the nominations are accepted.

Now that I'm a Casual Member, what's next?

1. Once you are a Casual Member, you will be able to nominate for ACA affiliated events, where the committee is accepting Casual/Event Memberships (as advertised on the program).
2. If your nominations are accepted into an ACA affiliated event, you will then receive an invoice for the \$100 (GST inc.) Event Membership along with your nominations invoice.

Please note all ACA membership types are non-refundable.
