There will be a steward at each event who will have each rider's name and age group, riders can complete the events in whatever order they would like.

Nominations open through 24th August 7am

Nominations must be paid by 28th August 5pm

All competitors must be accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or responsible adult.

Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA-affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.

1 horse per rider will be permitted.

Horses cannot be shared with other riders participating in the Gymkhana.

Gymkhana placings 1st to 4th in each event in all age groups.

Children in Led group must be led by an adult on foot and from the shoulder of the horse.

TERMS & CONDITIONS 1. AFFILIATION: Program is ACA Affiliated & run in accordance with the General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines'. 2. HELMETS: Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current Australian and New Zealand safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times. 3. SCRATCHING: A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee. 4. HORSE'S STATUS: The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft). 5. NOMINATION: Your ACA membership number must be provided otherwise your nomination will not be processed. Stock Levy has been changed. 6. JUVENILE/JUNIOR/MINI: Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and Juniors (8 years to under 13 years) Mini (under 8 years). 7. COMPLAINTS: "Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited" 8. MEMBERSHIP: ACA casual memberships are available, please call ACA and set up your account prior to nominations opening. ACA requires all Competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms. 9. STALLIONS: All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.11 of the ACA Rules. 10. All prizemoney payouts as per ACA Guidelines R9 (a) & (b). 11. The Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program as required depending on stock available for nominations received. 12. All competitors compete at their own risk. 13. Each competitor must acknowledge that it is a condition of acceptance of their nomination that neither the Campdraft Committee, The Council of The Shire of Banana or Theodore Sport and Recreation Association will not be responsible in respect of injury, loss, theft, accident or damage to competitors or their equipment. 14.
