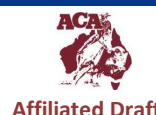

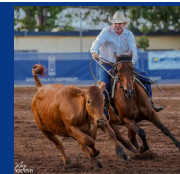

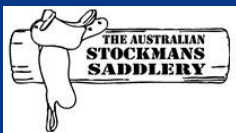

Conditions of Entry

1. **ALL COMPETITORS MUST COMPLETE A HORSE HEALTH DECLARATION FORM, AVAILABLE ON THIS PROGRAM ONLINE THROUGH CAMPDRAFT CENTRAL OR THE ACA WEBSITE, AND MUST BE HANDED INTO THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE ON ARRIVAL AT THE CHINCHILLA SHOW GROUNDS – A WRISTBAND WILL BE ISSUED ON RECEIPT OF PAPERWORK AND MUST TO BE WORN TO COMPETE.**
2. Nominations will be taken online through Campdraft Central (campdraftcentral.com.au) opening Wednesday 16th September 2026, 7am for 72 hours.
3. All competitors must be current 2026 financial members of the ACA and the ACA member number must be provided when nominating otherwise nominations will not be processed.
4. ACA casual memberships are available for this event, Anyone who wishes to nominate this way must call the ACA office and pay \$25 for a Casual Membership profile. Event membership of \$100 must then be paid to the committee. Please select this option when nominating if ACA casual membership is required.
5. Horses to be nominated in order in which horses are to be ridden.
6. **Full nomination fees must be received by COB Thursday 1st October 2026 via direct deposit. Failure to do so by this date will result in a forfeit of nominations to competitors on the wait list.**
7. The Chinchilla Campdraft Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program in any way whatsoever.
8. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries without any reason.
9. Changes to horse/rider must be done in writing at secretary's office no later than one hour before each event begins and accompanied by a \$20 change fee **NO CHANGES WILL BE ACCEPTED DURING EACH EVENT** Horse/Rider Change Form attached to this program and available at the secretary's office.
10. Campdraft competitors must hold themselves ready to compete at the advertised starting time on the day of the draft. Three calls will be made for competitors. If the competitor fails to appear nomination fees paid or due shall be forfeited to Chinchilla Campdraft Committee.
11. All competitors compete at own risk.
12. Program is ACA Affiliated & run in accordance with the ACA 'General Information Competition Rules & Guidelines'
13. ACA requires all Competitors to ensure all details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nomination platforms.
14. Per ACA rule 9.4 The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement Campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating e.g. if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft.
15. All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program.
16. Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited.
17. Any competitor who, in the opinion of the chief steward, deliberately mistreats or abuses stock will be disqualified from the event and also participating in any further events on the program.
18. All Prizemoney and refunds will be deposited directly into competitor's nominated bank account unless otherwise advised. Please ensure current bank account details are up to date in Campdraft Central.
19. Per ACA rule D5, a 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. **If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program, then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee.** If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
20. Per ACA rule B5 (e) Riders under the age of 18 must wear Helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times
21. All stallions are to be contained in accordance with Rule 11.12 of the ACA Rules

The information contained in this Horse Health Declaration is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.

I agree to abide by all conditions and directions of the Chinchilla A&P Association.

I acknowledge that failure to comply with the above may result in refusal of entry to the venue, disqualification or other disciplinary action as decided by the Judiciary/Disputes Committee.
