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**ACA Rules** – Apply to all events on this program.

**COMPLAINTS** - Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint must lodge the complaint in writing with a member of the committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$20 is forfeited.

**Horse/Rider Changes** – Must be submitted to the office **PRIOR** to the commencement of the event.

**Stallions:** Stallions are permitted to be unrestrained in panel yards throughout daylight hours but must be double tied after dark. Only 1 horse is permitted per enclosure. Panels must be a minimum height of 1500mm and constructed and constructed using and equivalent of 4 bars of a minimum width of 25mm box/pipe equivalent. Junior and Juvenile aged competitors are not permitted to handle or ride stallions whilst on the Capel Campdraft grounds. They must also have and electric tape perimeter around the enclosure . Please refer to the Stallion containment rules as per the ACA.

**Helmets:** Riders under the age of 18 must wear helmets whilst mounted on a horse at all ACA affiliated events. Helmets must comply with current safety standards and must be securely fastened under the chin at all times.  
Note: **ALL** competitors are encouraged to wear a helmet.

**Catering refreshments.** There will be no canteen so please bring your own supplies.

**Hay/Feed** – Bring your own (but please don't bring hay with Double gee or weed infestation).

Competitors to be **neat and presentable** at all times – Collared Long Sleeved Shirts (no T shirts), Boots, Jeans/Jodhpurs and Hats or Helmets (no caps) will be allowed in competition. This dress code applies to anyone riding in the arena at all times.

Grounds will be open from 9am Friday for all those competitors wishing to arrive early. Any competitors wishing to camp earlier please contact Phil to arrange payment . Camping is \$10 per truck per night..

**NO YARDS ARE TO BE ATTACHED TO TREES OR HAVE TREES IN THEM.**

### **Cross Country Jumps**

Please keep your horse yards well away from the cross country jumps. If you camp near the cross country jumps please do not yard your horses on the take-off or landing area. It would be preferable that the truck/car be on the take off/landing area so long as the water drains from any sink/shower aren't causing holes. Repairing the jumps and surfaces before and after the jumps is costly and time consuming.

Riders may not ride/jump any cross country jumps.

Anybody not strictly adhering to the above will be asked to vacate the grounds.
